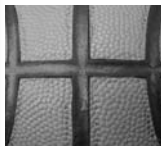


MEET THE 2008-09 BULLDOGS

Coach Dorow on DeNoyelles: Talented player who should contribute quickly ... Has personality and skills to fit well into the system ... Comes from an outstanding prep program ... Continues to gain confidence.

High School: A 2008 graduate of Mount Pleasant Sacred Heart High School ... Honored as Associated Press Class D Player of the Year ... Led team to 2008 MHSAA Class D State Final ... Picked up first team all-state recognition from the *Detroit News*, *Detroit Free Press*, Basketball Coaches Association of Michigan (BCAM) and the *Associated Press* ... Earned *Mt. Pleasant Morning Sun* "Dream Team" laurels ... Academic All-State recipient ... Totaled 17 points, five rebounds and 4.6 steals her final season ... Averaged 15.5 points, 4.7 rebounds and three assists per contest for the Irish as a junior ... Three-time (2005-08) Mid-State Athletic Conference recipient ... Led Mt. Pleasant Sacred Heart to a 21-3 overall record as a sophomore (2005) by pouring in 10.8 points and 4.5 rebounds an outing ... Averaged 9.8 points and 3.7 rebounds per contest in 2004 ... Coached on the prep level by her father, current FSU assistant Mark DeNoyelles ... Also competed in varsity softball in 2004.
