## Ferris State To Take Part In Fairmont State New Year's Classic

### FERRIS AT A GLANCE:

The Ferris State University women's basketball team, which is presently 3-8 overall and 2-2 in Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) action this campaign, will take part in the Fairmont State (W.Va.) New Year's Classic Monday and Tuesday, Jan. 3-4, in Fairmont, W.Va. FSU squares off against Concord (W.Va.) Monday (Jan. 3) and then faces host Fairmont State Tuesday (Jan. 4). Monday's contest tips off at 3 p.m. (EST) with Tuesday's game set for a 2 p.m. (EST) start.

**A SPLIT FOR FSU:** Ferris State split two games to close out the calendar year Thursday and Friday (Dec. 30-31) in the GLIAC/Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) Classic hosted by Northwood University at Midland, Mich. Ferris posted a 67-54 non-conference triumph over perennial Great Lakes Region power Northern Kentucky Thursday (Dec. 30) before dropping a 82-81 decision Friday (Dec. 31) to Southern Indiana. Sophomore guard **Kristin Reinhart (East Lansing)** spearheaded the Bulldog attack with a game-high 21 points versus NKU. Senior forward/center **Bridget Horwitz (Auburn, Ind./DeKalb)** chipped in 15 points for FSU and senior guard/forward **Lucie Cenkova (Prague, Czech Republic)** scored eight points. Horwitz and Reinhart both netted a game-high 20 points against USI. Horwitz also added 11 rebounds while Reinhart dished out nine assists. Cenkova chipped in 16 points versus the Screaming Eagles.

**A LOOK AT THE BULLDOGS:** FSU returns three starters and eight letter-winners from last season. The Bulldogs compiled a 21-10 overall record in 2003-04 and reached the NCAA Division II Great Lakes Regional Tournament for only the second time in school history. FSU placed second (14-4) in the GLIAC North Division and advanced to the GLIAC Tournament Championship game during the 2003-04 campaign. The Bulldogs also made their fifth consecutive conference tournament berth and recorded the program's second-ever 20-win campaign last season. Ferris has posted seven-straight winning seasons to date.

**HEAD COACH TRACEY FISK:** Seventh-year FSU head coach **Tracey Fisk** presently ranks as Ferris' all-time winningest coach with a current 109-69 (.612) career record at Ferris State. A 1996 graduate of Western Michigan, Fisk guided FSU to a 22-7 mark and the school's first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament appearance during the 1999-00 campaign. Prior to Ferris, Fisk spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan College (1994-97) and one season at the University of Indianapolis (1997-98). She needs nine victories to match Pat Dolan's (1977-89) school-record total of 118 wins at Ferris State.

**THE BULLDOG TRADITION:** The Ferris State women's basketball program, which is midst its 31st season of varsity competition, has compiled a 362-394 (.479) all-time mark. The Bulldogs won their only GLIAC crown, advanced to their first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament and recorded the nation's highest grade point average in 1999-2000. FSU, which also claimed GLIAC Tournament runner-up honors in 1999-00, has posted 10 or more victories eight consecutive seasons to date.

**JIM WINK ARENA:** Ferris has recorded a 41-15 (.732) overall record to date in games at Jim Wink Arena, including a 33-13 (.717) mark in league play. The 2,400-seat facility replaced the Old Jim Wink Arena, which was converted into the current Student Recreation Center after the 1997-98 campaign. FSU won its first 14 games in the facility.

**ON THE ROAD:** Ferris State is 146-109 (.573) overall since 1995-96 and sports an 85-74 (.535) record in road/neutral site contests during that span. The Bulldogs are 47-36 (.566) overall in road games under head coach **Tracey Fisk**, including a 33-23 (.589) record in GLIAC play.

**THE BULLDOG ROSTER:** Ferris' 2004-05 roster includes three seniors, three

juniors, two sophomores and five freshmen. Five of the 13 players are guards while the remaining eight are frontcourt players. Eleven players hail from Michigan with one each from Indiana and the Czech Republic. **GLIAC GAMES ON THE AIR:** FSU's 2004-05 league games will be carried live by local radio station WBRN-1460 AM. Selected contests can also be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at [www.ferris.edu/sports](http://www.ferris.edu/sports).

**ACADEMIC SUCCESS:** The 2003-04 Bulldog squad was honored for having the nation's 17th-highest cumulative grade point average in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll list. The Bulldogs, who placed among the top 25 teams for the fifth consecutive season, compiled a 3.384 grade point average in 2003-04. FSU, which previously compiled the nation's highest gpa (3.534) in 1999-00, also finished 21st (3.313) in 2001-02 and was 20th (3.388) for the 2000-01 academic year. Ferris' 3.604 gpa in 2002-03 placed tied for second.

**A LOOK AT CONCORD:** Ferris and Concord will square off for the first time ever Monday. The Mountain Lions are presently 6-2 overall and 0-2 in West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC) action this campaign following their 92-88 non-league home win over Belmont Abbey (N.C.) on Dec. 16th in Athens, W.Va. Concord, which has won three of its last four outings to date this season, is currently led in scoring by freshman forward **Samm Nester** (16.5 ppg). She tallied 41 points in the squad's win over Belmont Abbey. The Mountain Lions, who were 14-15 overall last season and recorded a 10-8 WVIAC mark, are guided by head coach **Kenny Osborne**. They were picked to finish seventh in the 2004-05 WVIAC Preseason Coaches Poll.

**ABOUT FAIRMONT STATE:** The Bulldogs have never faced Fairmont State heading into Tuesday's meeting. The Falcons were 21-8 overall in 2003-04 and compiled a 12-6 WVIAC record. Fairmont State, which was picked to finish third in the 2004-05 WVIAC Preseason Coaches Poll, is directed by fifth-year head coach **Steve McDonald**. The Falcons are currently 8-1 overall and 1-0 in league play this season following their 82-68 non-league triumph over Alaska-Anchorage in the Glacier Classic (Dec. 18) at Fairbanks, Alaska. Fairmont State will host St. Paul's (Va.) Sunday (Jan. 2) and Columbia Union (Md.) Monday (Jan. 3) before squaring off against the Bulldogs. Senior guard **Kristen Gattuso** is the Falcons' leading scorer (23.0 ppg) to date this campaign.

**BULLDOG BITES:** The 2004-05 campaign marked the second consecutive year the Bulldogs took part in the GLIAC/GLVC Classic at Midland. Last season (2003-04), Ferris lost to Indianapolis (12/19) 85-77 prior to beating Southern Illinois-Edwardsville (12/20) by a score of 86-71 ..... Ferris State is 2-0 all-time against West Virginia schools with both wins coming over West Virginia Wesleyan. The most recent was a 68-60 win in 1995-96.

**FSU PICKED SECOND:** Ferris was picked to finish second in the 2004-05 GLIAC North Division Preseason Coaches Poll. The Bulldogs totaled 32 points along with three first-place votes in the balloting conducted by the conference's head coaches. Lake Superior State was selected as the North Division favorite as the Lakers recorded 33 points and four first-place votes. Ashland took the top spot in the South Division with 24 points. Each of the league's 13 head coaches ranked the teams in their respective divisions, but were not allowed to vote for their own team. The first-place team in the North Division received six points while the second-place team earned four points, etc. The first-place squad in the South Division picked up five points, second place took four points, etc.

**BETWEEN THE LINES:** FSU head coach **Tracey Fisk** will make periodic appearances throughout the season on "Between The Lines," a weekly half-hour television show devoted to Ferris State Athletics. The program, which is hosted by **Shannon Vesper** and produced by FSU's media productions department, airs each Tuesday and Wednesday at 7 p.m. (ET) and 8 p.m. (ET), respectively, on FSU's Cable Channel 7.
