Coach Fisk on Reinhart: "Kristin plays with poise and is a great leader. She's capable of scoring and creating openings for her teammates. Her style of play allows her to flourish in our system."

College: 2003-04: Played in 31 games and started six contests ... Ranked as squad's fourth-leading scorer (8.5 ppg) ... Tallied season-high 18 points versus Michigan Tech (3/2) ... Compiled 13 double-figure scoring efforts ... Had 17 points and sank three treys at Michigan Tech (2/5) ... Twice led the squad in scoring ... Tallied seven points and six assists in her collegiate debut at Lewis, Ill. (11/15) ... Garnered a season-best seven assists against Northwood (1/29) ... Averaged 11.1 points per game in her final eight outings ... Earned team Rookie of the Year Award ... Recorded average of 15.7 points per game in three meetings against Michigan Tech ... Ranked 23rd among GLIAC's assists leaders (2.35 apg).

High School: A 2003 graduate of East Lansing High School ... Averaged 18 points, four rebounds and two assists per game while leading ELHS to a 20-3 overall record as a senior ... Attained first-team 2002 Class A All-State recognition from the Associated Press, Detroit News, Detroit Free Press and the Basketball Coaches Association of Michigan ... Finished fifth in the voting for Michigan's Miss Basketball Award ... Was a member of the Lansing State Journal's Dream Team ... Twice (2001-02) earned All-Capital Area Conference (CAC) honors ... Garnered team MVP Award accolades twice (2001-02) ... Holds school records for consecutive free throws made in a game (6) and in a season (20) along with most three-point baskets (6) in a contest ... Was a 2002 BCAM Academic All-State pick ... Earned team Best Offensive Player Award ... Garnered school's Rookie of the Year and Hustle Awards as a sophomore ... Coached by Rob Smith ... Received 2002 MHSAA Division II All-State golf accolades ... Four-time All-CAC golf honoree.

Coach Fisk on Thwing: "Audrey has solid skills and is playing stronger than last season. She's more aggressive and is learning to use her left hand. Her determination to keep her head up is encouraging to our younger players."

College: 2003-04: Saw action in four contests ... Totaled a season-high six points in her collegiate debut at Quincy, Ill. (11/22) ... Compiled nine points and five rebounds in 23 minutes of action ... Was three-of-three from the field versus Quincy ... Scored two points along with registering both one blocked shot and one assist in her final outing at Saginaw Valley State (12/13) ... Sank one-of-two free throw attempts while playing a season-high 10 minutes versus Kentucky Wesleyan (11/30) ... Shot 50% from the floor for the season.

High School: A 2003 graduate of Davison High School ... Earned honorable mention 2002 Detroit Free Press Class A All-State accolades ... Guided DHS to a 12-9 overall record while averaging 19.6 points and 11 rebounds per contest during the 2002 campaign ... Was a 2002 All-Big Nine Athletic Conference (BNAC) First Team honoree ... Served as the squad's captain ... Selected among the Detroit News' Top 100 players in 2002 ... Received All-BNAC Third Team recognition twice (2000-01) ... Totaled 10.4 points and eight rebounds per game as the Cardinals compiled a 13-8 overall record in 2001 ... Recognized as a four-year letterwinner ... Garnered BNAC All-Academic Award recognition twice ... Coached by Ray Timmerman ... Attained honorable mention All-BNAC honors in volleyball and track and field as a senior ... Also played Amateur Athletic Union basketball for the Flint (Mich.) Swish, Mid-Michigan Mystics, Downriver Ravens, Motor City Blazers and the Orion Shock.
