Nova Southeastern Notes:

✓ The Sharks are presently 6-3 overall this campaign. Nova Southeastern defeated Kentucky Wesleyan 75-58 in its most recent action (12/18) at home. The Sharks are a member of the Sunshine State Conference and have won their last three outings to date. Marilyn Rule-Heinrich is midst her eighth season as the program's only head coach. The Lady Sharks set a school record with 17 wins last season as they placed tied for second in the SSC.

Barry Notes:

✓ Barry currently holds a 3-7 overall record this season following its 73-59 loss to Kentucky Wesleyan (12/19) in the Cruzin' Classic held in Miami Shores, Fla. The Buccaneers have lost five of their last six outings to date this season and are 0-1 in Sunshine State Conference action. Nicci Hays-Fort is in her fourth season as the program's head coach and led Barry to a 15-13 overall record during the 2004-05 campaign. Barry will face Millersville (Pa.) in its first game of the Buccaneer Classic Thursday (Dec. 29).

FSU GAME NOTES

✓ The Ferris State University women's basketball team will take part in the Barry (Fla.) Buccaneer Holiday Classic Thursday and Friday, Dec. 29-30, in Miami Shores, Fla. The Bulldogs square off against Nova Southeastern (Fla.) Thursday (Dec. 29) at 4 p.m. (EST) and will then meet host Barry in Friday's (Dec. 30) 6 p.m. (EST) contest. Ferris is presently 5-5 overall this campaign and has won two of its last three outings to date this year.

✓ Ferris State University is a NCAA Division II school located in Big Rapids, Mich., with an enrollment of 12,547. The Bulldogs are a member of the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC). Big Rapids is located in West Michigan approximately 60 miles north of Grand Rapids or 40 miles west of Mount Pleasant, Mich.

✓ No Ferris State radio or internet coverage will be available for either of the non-conference games.

✓ Ferris State finished the 2004-05 season with an 11-17 overall record. FSU placed fourth in the GLIAC North Division with a 9-9 conference ledger and advanced to the league's postseason tournament for the sixth consecutive year. The Bulldogs also recorded their ninth-straight season with 10 or more victories.

✓ Ferris' 2005-06 roster includes one senior, three juniors, four sophomores and six freshmen. Five of the 14 players are guards while the remaining nine are frontcourt players. All 12 players on the roster hail from Michigan. Forward **Kelly McLaughlin (Clare)** is the only senior on the roster.

✓ The Ferris State women's basketball program, which is midst its 32nd season of varsity competition, has compiled a 375-408 (.479) all-time mark. The Bulldogs won their only GLIAC crown, advanced to their first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament and recorded the nation's highest grade point average in 1999-2000. FSU, which also claimed GLIAC Tournament runner-up honors in 1999-00, has posted 10 or more victories nine consecutive seasons to date.

BULLDOG BITES

✓ The Bulldogs compiled a 21-10 overall record in 2003-04 and reached the NCAA Division II Great Lakes Regional Tournament for only the second time in school history. FSU placed second (14-4) in the GLIAC North Division and advanced to the GLIAC Tournament Championship game during the 2003-04 campaign. The Bulldogs also made their fifth consecutive conference tournament berth and recorded the program's second-ever 20-win campaign two seasons ago.

✓ Eighth-year FSU head coach **Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk** presently ranks as Ferris' all-time winningest coach with a current 122-83 (.595) career record at Ferris State. A 1996 graduate of Western Michigan, Fisk guided FSU to a 22-7 mark and the school's first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament appearance during the 1999-00 campaign. Prior to Ferris, Fisk spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan College (1994-97) and one season at the University of Indianapolis (1997-98).

✓ Ferris State was picked to finish fourth in the 2005-06 GLIAC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason North Division Poll released by the league office. The Bulldogs totaled 23 points in the balloting, which was conducted by the conference's head coaches. A year ago, Ferris State took second place in the conference's preseason coaches poll with 32 points and three first-place votes. Grand Valley State was selected as the North Division favorite as the Lakers recorded 36 points along with six first-place votes. Gannon and Hillsdale tied for the top spot in the South Division with 21 points and three first-place votes apiece.

✓ FSU junior guards **Kristin Reinhart (East Lansing)** and **Erin Miller (Niles)** were chosen among the top 10 West Michigan collegiate players to watch this year by the *Grand Rapids Press* in the Nov. 15 edition. The women's rankings honored Reinhart as the second overall selection while Miller came in seventh. Grand Valley State tallied four of the top 10 picks, including the number one honoree in 2004-05 GLIAC Player of the Year Niki Reams. Ferris placed second with two nominations followed by Calvin, Aquinas, Hope and Davenport with one apiece.

✓ The Barry Buccaneer Holiday Classic will be a homecoming of sorts for

fourth-year FSU assistant coach **Justin Rees**. Rees, who previously served for three seasons (1999-02) as an assistant coach at NCAA-II Teikyo Post (Conn.), played collegiate basketball at Barry (Fla.) from 1993-97 and prepped at Major Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Fla.

✓ The Bulldogs have ranked among the nation's top academic programs six consecutive seasons, according to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll list. FSU placed 14th overall in 2004-05 with a 3.432 grade point average. Ferris had the nation's highest gpa in 1999-00 and placed second in 2002-03.

✓ Ferris head coach **Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk** became the school's all-time victory leader with two wins in the Aquinas College Classic (Nov. 18-19). Bloodworth-Fisk, who also ranks as FSU's all-time winningest coach, surpassed Pat Dolan's (1977-89) previous school-record total of 118 wins at FSU. Both of FSU's two all-time NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances have come under Bloodworth-Fisk. She was honored as the GLIAC's 2003-04 Women's Basketball Coach of the Year after guiding the Bulldogs to the program's second-ever 20-win campaign.

✓ Ferris has set several school records this campaign. FSU's 17 made three-pointers and 39 attempts behind the arc against Lewis (Dec. 21) in the FSU Holiday Classic both surpassed previous school records. Ferris also set a new school record with 31 assists at home against Northwood (Dec. 1).

✓ Ferris recently announced the addition of prep guard **Stephanie DeNoyelles (Mt. Pleasant/Sacred Heart)** and prep forward/center **Andrea Clancy (Port Austin/North Huron)**, who both plan to attend and compete in women's basketball at FSU beginning with the 2006-07 academic year. They inked national letters-of-intent with the Bulldogs during the fall signing period. The 5-7 DeNoyelles attained both first-team *Detroit Free Press* and honorable mention *Detroit News* Class D All-State kudos this campaign while Clancy was chosen to the *Associated Press* Class D All-State Girls Basketball Team.
