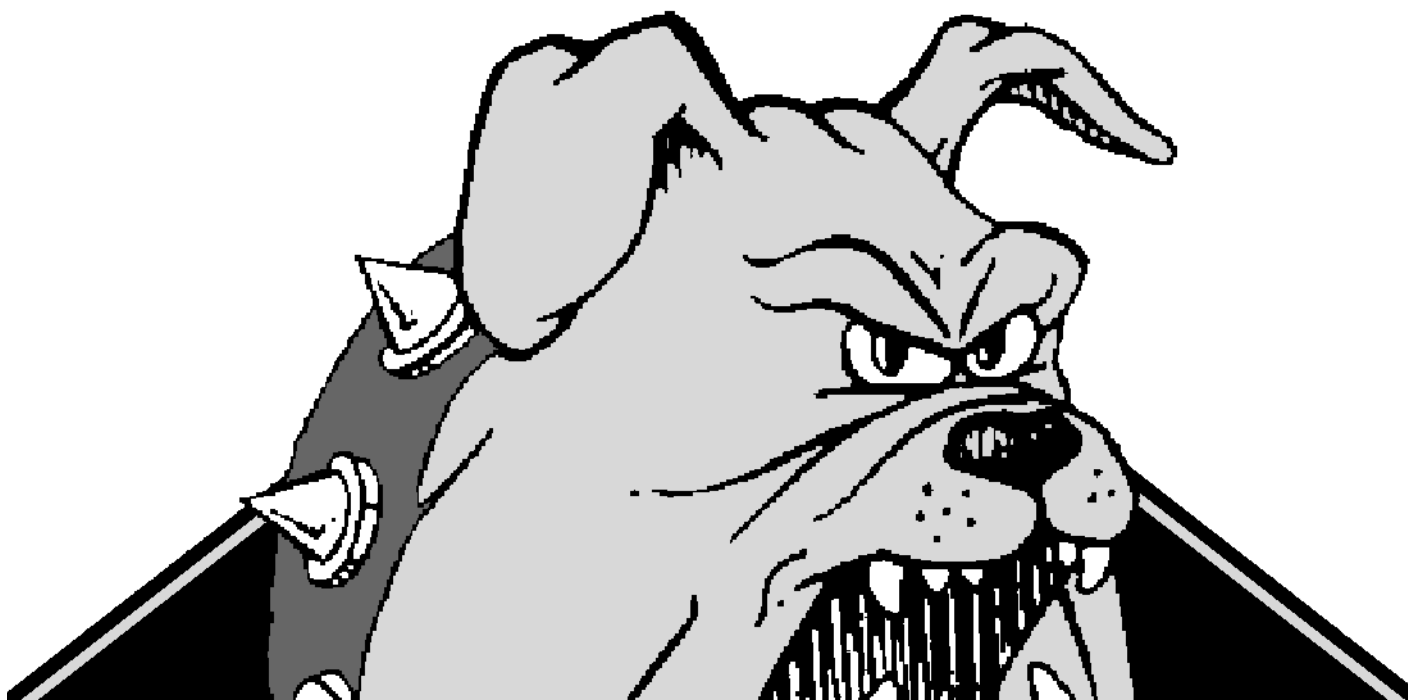

BULLDOG WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME DAY

WOMEN'S GAME DAY INFORMATION

TODAY'S GAME: Ferris State University's women's basketball squad hosts the Hillsdale Chargers Saturday, Jan. 6, in Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) action inside FSU's Jim Wink Arena at Big Rapids, Mich. Tipoff is slated for 1 p.m. (EST).

FSU vs. HILLSDALE: Ferris holds a 32-16 series edge entering Saturday's 49th encounter and recorded a thrilling 79-78 triumph (1/7/06) in last season's only meeting at Hillsdale, Mich. The Bulldogs have won six of the last 10 series' matchups overall. FSU head coach Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk currently has a 6-4 career coaching mark versus HC.

A LOOK AT THE CHARGERS: Hillsdale, which is coached by fifth-year head coach Claudette Charney, is presently 7-5 overall and 2-2 in league play after Thursday's (Jan. 4) 74-51 league road win at Saginaw Valley State. The Chargers compiled a 17-11 overall record and a second-place 10-7 GLIAC mark in 2005-06. Senior forward Lauren Fewins presently ranks as Hillsdale's leading scorer (14.1 ppg) this campaign. HC, which was picked to finish second in the 2006-07 GLIAC South Division Preseason Coaches Poll, has dropped five of its last seven outings to date this year. Charney previously spent seven seasons (1995-02) as the head coach at Grand Valley State along with 10 seasons at Saginaw Valley State and is the wife of former FSU Faculty Athletics Representative Mark Kosciuszko.

JIM WINK ARENA: Ferris has recorded a 57-23 (.713) overall record to date in games at Jim Wink Arena, including a 44-20 (.688) mark in league play. The 2,400-seat facility replaced the Old Jim Wink Arena, which was converted into the current Student Recreation Center after the 1997-98 campaign. FSU won its first 14 games in the facility.

A LOOK BACK AT LAST SEASON: Ferris State wrapped up its 2005-06 women's basketball season with an 18-10 overall record and made its seventh consecutive GLIAC Tournament appearance last campaign. FSU, which posted a third-place tying 12-6 mark in GLIAC North Division play a year ago, also registered

BULLDOG BITES

Ferris State needs only four wins to record the program's 400th all-time victory Ferris head coach **Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk** needs seven more wins to notch her 150th all-time career coaching victory The Bulldogs have outrebounded their opponents in nine of 12 games this season FSU seniors **Erin Miller** and **Kristin Reinhart** along with junior **Rachel Folcik** are serving as the Bulldogs' team captains for the 2006-07 campaign FSU will play each of its next four contests on the road following Saturday's game against Hillsdale Senior forward **Audrey Thwing** is 16 points away from posting her 500th career point at FSU The Bulldogs have ranked among the nation's top academic programs seven consecutive seasons, according to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll list **Rachel Folcik** earned this week's (Jan. 2) GLIAC North Division Player of the Week honor for her performance over the holiday break. Folcik averaged 17.8 points along with 8.5 rebounds and 2.3 steals in the four-game stretch (Dec. 18-Jan. 1) **Rachel Folcik** grabbed her 400th career rebound at Southern Illinois-Edwardsville (Dec. 30) The Bulldogs have held the opposition to 57 points or less in two of the last three contests **Erin Miller** is presently 10 steals away from recording her 200th career theft Ferris hits the road starting next week for a four-game conference road swing, which includes two games in Michigan's Upper Peninsula at Northern Michigan (Jan. 11) and Michigan Tech (Jan. 13) along with a trip to Erie, Pa., to face both Mercyhurst (Jan. 18) and Gannon (Jan. 20) The Bulldogs' next home encounter will be against Ashland Thursday, Jan. 25, beginning at 6 p.m. (EST) inside Jim Wink Arena **Teghan Thelen** and **Kristin Reinhart** have both notched three consecutive double-figure scoring performances for the Bulldogs. **Rachel Folcik** has reached double-digit scoring in five-straight games to date Both **Teghan Thelen** and **Ashley Fleming** netted personal career-highs with 13 and eight points, respectively, in FSU's last home outing against St. Francis (Dec. 20). **Katie Loosvelt** matched a personal-best with 10 points in the game.

Jan. 4, 2007 - This was the kind of win that fans of the Hillsdale College women's basketball team have been used to seeing over the past several seasons.

Combining quick, high-pressure defense with an efficient offense, the Hillsdale College women's basketball team played one of its best all-around games of the season, defeating Saginaw Valley State University Thursday night, 74-51, in a GLIAC game in Saginaw. Hillsdale improves to 7-5 overall with the win, and is 2-2 in the GLIAC. The Cardinals fall to 4-8 overall and 2-3 in the GLIAC with the loss.

Right from the opening tip-off, the Chargers played with intensity and cohesion, using their depth and athleticism to grab a huge early lead, never looking back. Hillsdale built a 23-8 lead in the first 14 minutes of the game, and were never seriously threatened after that. The Cardinals shot just 5-for-23 from the field as a team in the first half, a credit to Hillsdale's aggressive defense.

Hillsdale has had an up-and-down season so far. After getting off to a 5-0 start, the Chargers suffered through a five-game losing streak that brought their record down to the .500 mark. But Hillsdale has rebounded to post lopsided wins over St. Joseph (87-59) and now SVSU (74-51).

Five players scored at least eight points for Hillsdale in the win, led by another outstanding effort from senior Lauren Fewins. The team's leading scorer this season, Fewins knocked down six 3-point baskets en route to a team-high 22 points in the game. Fewins also grabbed seven rebounds and shot 7-for-10 from the field.

Senior guard Jessie Miller was the only other Hillsdale player to crack double figures in scoring, netting 13. But Miller played superb team defense, while running the team's offense in an efficient manner. Senior Crystal Yoder added nine points, while seniors Jodie Haines and Nikki Wustman each scored eight in the win.

As a team, the Chargers shot 14-for-24 from 3-point territory, and had 21 assists on 27 made field goals. Hillsdale limited SVSU to 27 percent shooting from the floor, and trailed just once in the game, 2-0.

Hillsdale will seek its third straight win Saturday vs. Ferris State University in Big Rapids, starting at 1 p.m.
