Coach Dorow on Loosvelt: *Playing with sense of urgency ... Ready to leave mark on program ... Extremely quick ... Makes her teammates better ... Solid pressure defender on the ball ... Has the ability to hustle anyone.*

College: 2006-07: Named to GLIAC All-Academic Team ... Had 12 points vs. Marygrove (2/22) and 10 points vs. St. Francis (12/20) ... Totaled 95 points and 43 rebounds ... Started five games and played in 31 contests ... Netted seven assists vs. Northwood (2/3) ... Had five assists or more in three other games ... 2005-06: Appeared in all 28 outings ... Finished fourth on the team with 42 assists ... Totaled 58 points and 28 rebounds in 333 minutes ... Had a season-best eight points against SIU-Edwardsville (12/20) ... Compiled four assists or more in six contests, including five at Barry, Fla. (12/30) ... 2004-05: Received action in all 28 games and started the final eight outings ... Netted a season-best 10 points at Wayne State (1/15) ... Had nine points on three other occasions ... Finished the year second on team with 84 assists ... Tallied eight assists at Northwood (1/16).

High School: A 2004 graduate of Carlson High School ... Tallied a school single-season record 20.4 points per game in 2003 ... Three-time (2001-03) All-Michigan Mega Conference Gold Division honoree ... Led Marauders to an 18-3 overall record and a conference title in 2003 ... Attained both *Detroit Free Press* and *Detroit News* Class B All-State accolades ... Three-time (2001-03) all-region pick ... Ranked as CHS' all-time leader in career assists (337), steals (424) and field goal percentage (.502) ... Team MVP ... Competed in volleyball, soccer along with track and field.

Scored over 1,000 career points ... Team captain ... Team advanced to Michigan Class C Final Four in 2002 ... Won four AAU state titles ... Competed in volleyball and softball.
