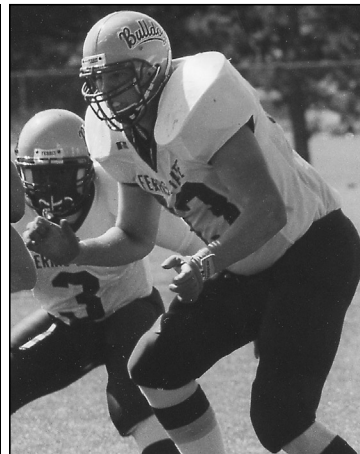
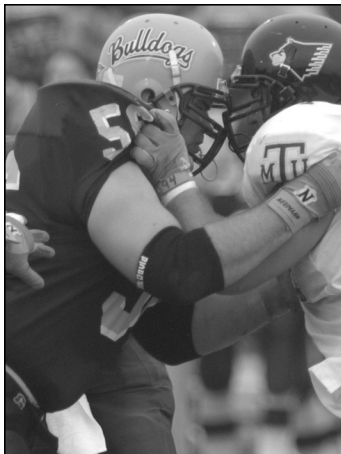

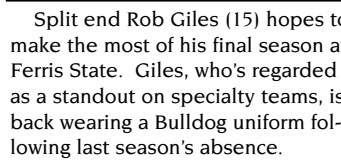

Sophomore Jamie Bretl (75) will be a center of attention for the opposition's defensive front this campaign. Bretl, who started out his FSU career at tackle, started all of last season's 10 games at center and was a GLIAC All-Academic pick.
