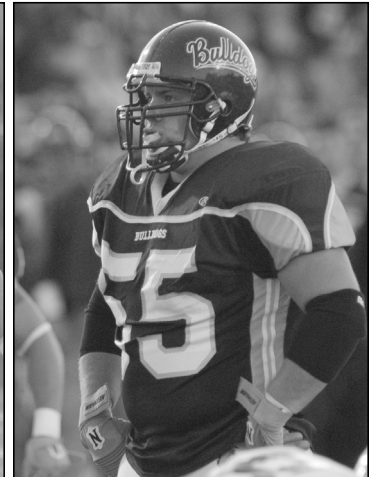

An imposing figure in the trenches at 6-4, 327 pounds, sophomore guard Allen Feigel was honored as Ferris State's Outstanding Offensive Rookie in 2003. The athletic lineman appeared in nine contests last season and received the starting nod at right guard in the final eight encounters.

Senior defensive tackle Whitney Bell has developed a reputation as a feared tackler and pass rusher throughout the conference. Bell was selected as a second-team All-America and Northeast Region First-Team selection by *Hansen's Football Gazette* last season. He also picked up All-GLIAC First-Team laurels and was the recipient of FSU's Most Valuable Defensive Lineman Award after notching a career-best 99 tackles which was tops among the conference's defensive linemen.
