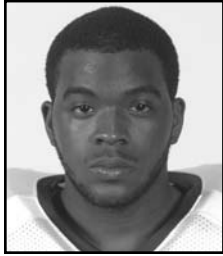

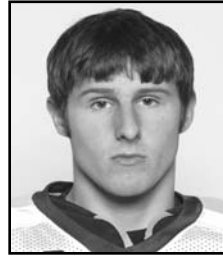

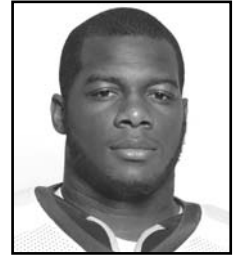

Preseason All-America selection . . . Has great size for a cornerback . . . One of league's best at his position . . . Expected to provide a valuable contribution as a starter . . . Started the final nine games in 2007 . . . Appeared in all 11 contests . . . Received All-GLIAC Second Team plaudits . . . Honored as team's Outstanding Defensive Rookie for 2007 . . . Compiled 36 total tackles, including 24 solo stops . . . Also had two interceptions . . . Ranked fourth in the league in passes defended (1.00 pg.) . . . Netted a team-high tying nine pass breakups . . . Also recovered a fumble and forced a fumble . . . Totaled five or more tackles in five contests . . . Placed ninth on the team in total stops . . . Transferred from Grand Rapids Community College prior to last season . . . Prepped at Lansing Everett High School . . . FSU Letters: One . . . Major: Recreation Leadership Management.

Talented linebacker . . . Veteran leader who works hard . . . Fourth-year starter . . . Great technician . . . Started all 11 games in 2007 . . . Ranked fourth on the squad with 69 total stops . . . GLIAC All-Academic Team pick . . . Twice had 11 tackles in a game last year . . . Started 10 games in 2006 . . . Placed third on team with 80 total tackles . . . Also had two pass breakups and a quarterback hurry . . . Had three games with 10 or more tackles . . . Attained 2005 GLIAC All-Academic honors and was FSU's Most Improved Defensive Player . . . Totaled 91 tackles to rank third among team leaders in '05 . . . Played in all 11 2005 games and started last 10 outings . . . Had five double-figure tackle outings, including 16 stops vs. Northwood (10/29) in 2005 . . . Earned All-Western Lakes Conference plaudits in senior year at Stevenson High . . . Coached by Tim Grabel . . . Received All-Metro West accolades by *Detroit News* and *Detroit Free Press* . . . Posted a school single-season best 131 tackles as a senior . . . Two-time (2002-03) team MVP . . . Helped Spartans to a 7-3 record and a 2002 state playoff appearance . . . His father, Tim, played football at Central Michigan (1976-79) . . . Talented back with big-play potential . . . Contending again for starting job in the backfield . . . Slashing-type of runner with tremendous speed . . . Fast and strong . . . Competitive . . . Runs hard with the ball . . . Made eight starts and played in 11 contests last fall . . . Placed third on team with 328 net rushing yards and had four TD's . . . Also caught 11 passes for 49 yards . . . Played in initial three games during 2006 season before being injured . . . Gained 77 yards on 16 carries . . . Appeared in final five 2005 contests and rushed for 60 yards on 14 attempts . . . Two-time (2003-04) all-state honorable mention honoree at Avondale High under coach Steve Deutsch . . . Three-time (2002-04) all-league and team MVP pick . . . Twice named to the all-county and All-North teams . . . Eclipsed the 1,000-yard rushing mark his last three years and ranks 11th all-time in the state . . . Finished prep career with 45 career TD's . . . Posted 1,354 yards and 23 TD's on the ground as a senior after running for 1,261 yards and 12 TD's in junior year . . . School record holder for most single-game and career yards . . .
