**GOLF WORLD ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF
SECOND MEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE FALL SEASON**

Barry Replaces Florida Southern as Top Team

NEW YORK, NY—The second *Golf World*/Nike Golf Division II Coaches' Poll of the fall season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine, Nike Golf and the Golf Coaches Association of America (GCAA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I, III and the NAIA, will appear in the September 21 issue of *Golf World* and can be viewed online now at www.golfworld.com.

Despite not playing its season-opener, Barry University jumped past Florida Southern to take the No. 1 spot in the poll, earning five of 11 first-place votes. The two schools will face off at the Coker Invitational, September 24-25. Rounding out the top five are Florida Southern (No. 2), Columbus State (No. 3), USC-Aiken (No. 4) and West Florida (No. 5).

Armstrong Atlantic State (No. 6) and Nova Southeastern (No. 10) have jumped into the top-ten, after being ranked No. 12 and No. 13, respectively, in the previous coaches' poll. The Pirates notched a second-place finish at the Kiawah Island Invitational last week; the Sharks will open their season at the Coker Invitational. Northeastern State (No. 25) is the lone team to move into the top-25.
