**GOLF WORLD ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF
SECOND WOMEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE SPRING SEASON**

Florida Southern and Rollins Share Top Spot

NEW YORK, NY—The second *Golf World*/NGCA Division II Coaches' Poll of the spring season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine and the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I and III, will appear in the March 21st issue of *Golf World* and can be viewed online now at www.golfworld.com.

Florida Southern and Rollins are tied for the number one spot in the poll as each team earned 243 points overall. Florida Southern earned six of the 10 first-place votes while Rollins received the other four. Rollins grabbed its share of the top spot by winning the Peggy Kirk Bell Invitational, its third win of the 2007-08 season. Florida Southern finished third in the event but has four wins on the season.

Rounding out the top five are Ferris State (No. 3), Tarleton State (No. 4) and Barry (No. 5). Chico State (No. 24) joins the top-25.
