***GOLF WORLD* ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF FIFTH AND FINAL
WOMEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE SPRING SEASON**

Nova Southeastern Ends the Regular Season as Top Team in D-II Poll

NEW YORK, NY—The fifth and final *Golf World*/NGCA Division II Coaches' Poll of the spring season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine and the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I and III, will appear in the May 11 issue of *Golf World* and can be viewed online now at www.golfworld.com.

Nova Southeastern remains in the top spot in the D-II poll, securing seven of the nine first-place votes. The Sharks have five tournament victories this season and advanced out of the NCAA South Regional this week to make it into a 12-team field that will play at the NCAA Championship later this month.

Rollins moved up from No. 3 to No. 2, after winning the Sunshine Conference Championship. The Tars received the other two first-place votes.

Rounding out the top-five are Florida Southern (No. 3), Grand Valley State (T-4) and Lynn (T-4).

There are no new teams in the top-10. Southern Indiana (T-25) is the only new squad in the top-25 this week.
