THIS WEEKEND: The Ferris State University men's ice hockey team will continue Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) play this weekend (Nov. 17-18) as the Bulldogs entertain the nationally-ranked University of Michigan Wolverines in a two-game set at Big Rapids, Mich.

FACEOFF/ARENA: Friday & Saturday - 7:05 p.m. (EST)/Ewingleben Ice Arena (*pronounced A-VAH-glave-in*) (2,493).

BROADCAST INFORMATION: All of Ferris State's 2006-07 CCHA games will be carried live by local radio station **Big Country WWBR-100.9 FM** with **Bill Beckwith** calling the action. THE RECORDS: Ferris State skated to a 0-1-1 record in last week's (11/7 & 11/10) CCHA action versus nationally-ranked Michigan State. The Bulldogs posted a 2-2 overtime league tie last Tuesday (11/7) at MSU's Munn Ice Arena in East Lansing, Mich. FSU then suffered a 6-0 loss to the Spartans in last Friday's (11/10) encounter at Big Rapids, Mich. Ferris is 2-4-0 at home and 1-2-1 on the road this season to date.

☛ Last season, Ferris State was 17-15-8 overall which included a sixth place-tying 10-11-7 CCHA record. The Bulldogs were 8-6-4 at home, 8-8-3 on the road and 1-1-1 at neutral sites.

Michigan improved to 7-3-0 overall and 4-2-0 in the CCHA with a league home series sweep of Nebraska-Omaha last weekend (11/10-11) at UM's Yost Ice Arena in Ann Arbor, Mich. The Wolverines posted a 6-4 victory over the Mavericks in last Friday's (11/10) series' opener before claiming a 5-1 triumph in Saturday's (11/11) rematch to win its third straight outing to date. UM is 0-1-0 on the road and 7-2-0 at home to date this season. The Wolverines are ranked eighth this week in all three major polls - *Inside College Hockey.com* (INCH), *USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine*, and *U.S. College Hockey Online/CSTV*.

with a third-place 13-10-5 CCHA mark. The Wolverines made their NCAA-record 16th straight NCAA Tournament appearance last season and have won two national titles (1996 & 1998) during the streak.

THE COACHES: Ferris State - **Bob Daniels** (Michigan State, 1982), 15th season, 228-270-49 (.462) - (10-28-2 vs. Michigan - 6-9-1 Home, 4-17-0 Away, 0-2-1 Neutral). Michigan - **Gordon "Red" Berenson** (Michigan, 1962), 23rd season, 592-281-63 (.666) - (50-21-2 vs. Ferris State). Berenson is UM's all-time winningest coach and ranks eighth on NCAA Hockey's all-time coaching victories list.

ABOUT MICHIGAN: The Wolverines have six skaters with double-figure points total, led by junior forward Kevin Porter (10-9=19) and senior forward T.J. Hensick (4-15=19), the team's leading scorer (17-35=52) last season and a 2005-06 All-CCHA Second Team honoree. Porter and Hensick are both tied for fourth nationally in points per game (1.90 avg.). Sophomore Billy Sauer (7-3-0, 3.29 GAA, .886sv%) is UM's primary goaltender. The Wolverines have the nation's top-ranked scoring offense (4.90 avg.).

Seven of the last 10 meetings have been decided by one goal or less and Ferris State is 4-4-1 in those contests.

Four of the last eight outings have been extra-session encounters with the Bulldogs sporting a 3-0-1 mark in such games.

SERIES NOTES

◆ Ferris State and Michigan will meet for the 84th and 85th times this weekend in a series which the Wolverines have a 54-26-3 lead. The all-time series dates back to the 1981-82 season.

◆ **OVERTIME** -- Ferris State is 4-3-3 in such contests versus Michigan.

◆ **THE SITE** -- Ferris is 16-20-2 at home, 10-32-0 on the road, and 0-2-1 at neutral sites versus Michigan.

◆ **BOB DANIELS vs. Michigan** -- 10-28-2 overall (6-9-1 home, 4-17-0 road, and 0-2-1 neutral).

SERIES NOTES - Ferris State is 8-23-2 (.273) against Michigan in the last 33 meetings between the two teams - 4-6-1 at home, 4-16-0 on the road, and 0-1-1 at neutral sites. Ferris is averaging 2.61 goals per game (86 total) to Michigan's 4.45 average (147 total) for a +1.84 goals differential during the 33-game period.

◆ Ferris State is 9-30-0 (.231) in games decided by three goals or more - 6-13-0 at home and 3-17-0 on the road.

◆ The Bulldogs are 17-24-3 (.420) in contests decided by two goals or less - 10-7-2 at home, 7-15-0 on the road, and 0-2-1 at neutral sites.

◆ Ferris State is 5-2-1 in its last eight home outings versus Michigan at the Ewigeleben Ice Arena.
