## GAMES 23-24 ▲ 2007-08 SEASON

**THIS WEEKEND:** The Ferris State University men's ice hockey team will square off against the Western Michigan University Broncos this weekend (Jan. 25-26) in a Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) home-and-home series. Ferris visits WMU in this Friday's (Jan. 25) series opener at Kalamazoo, Mich., before the Bulldogs host the Broncos in this Saturday's (Jan. 26) rematch at Big Rapids, Mich.

**FACEOFF/ARENA:** Friday – 7:35 p.m. (EST)/Lawson Ice Arena (3,667) & Saturday – 7:05 p.m. (EST)/Ewingleben Ice Arena (*pronounced A-VAH-glave-in*) (2,493).

**THE BROADCAST:** All of Ferris State's 2007-08 CCHA games will be carried live by local radio station **Big Country WWBR-100.9 FM** with **Bill Beckwith** calling the action. The contests can be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at [www.ferris.edu/sports](http://www.ferris.edu/sports). **VIDEO WEBCASTS:** A live video and audio webcast is available for all 2007-08 Ferris State home hockey games through B2Networks for a charge of \$6 per contest. **THE RECORDS:** Ferris State is 10-10-2 overall and 7-8-1 in the CCHA following a league series split against Northern Michigan last weekend (Jan. 18-19) at FSU's Ewingleben Ice Arena in Big Rapids. The Bulldogs are 5-4-1 in their last 10 contests to date. FSU is 5-4-0 on the road and 4-6-2 at home this campaign.   
 ● Ferris State compiled a 14-22-3 overall record a season ago, which included a ninth-place 10-16-2 CCHA mark.

Western Michigan dropped to 6-17-1 overall and 2-14-0 in the CCHA to date after dropping both games of a league home-and-home series against Bowling Green State last weekend (Jan. 18-19). The Broncos suffered a 4-1 loss to the Falcons in last Friday's (Jan. 18) series opener at the BGSU Ice Arena in Bowling Green, Ohio. WMU then came out on the short end of a 2-1 overtime loss to Bowling Green in Saturday's (Jan. 19) tilt at WMU's Lawson Ice Arena in Kalamazoo, Mich. The Broncos, who are midst a six-game losing skid, are 5-8-0 at home and 1-8-0 on the road this campaign.   
 ● A season ago, Western Michigan compiled an 18-18-1 overall record with a sixth-place 14-13-1

CCHA ledger.

**THE COACHES:** Ferris State – **Bob Daniels** (Michigan State, 1982), 16th season, 249-296-53 (.461) – (25-24-2 vs. Western Michigan – 10-14-1 Away, 14-9-1 Home, 1-1-0 Neutral). **Western Michigan – Jim Culhane** (Western Michigan, 1987), 9th season, 134-172-31 (.444) – (14-18-0 vs. Ferris State). Culhane, who played at WMU from 1983-87, is the first former Bronco varsity player to serve as the program's head coach. He went on to play five professional seasons, including a stint with the NHL's Hartford Whalers in 1989-90.

**ABOUT WESTERN MICHIGAN:** Junior right wing Patrick Galivan (7-15=22) currently leads the Broncos in scoring this season. Junior left wing Jeff LoVecchio (7-8=15), freshman center Max Campbell (3-10=13), and sophomore left wing Cam Watson (7-3=10) have also posted double-digit points totals. Sophomore Riley Gill (4-12-0, 3.44 GAA, .892sv%) and frosh Jerry Kuhn (2-5-1, 2.27 GAA, .925sv%) have been WMU's goaltenders this season. Nationally, the Broncos are tops in penalty minutes (20.0 avg.) per game.

 ◆ The Bulldogs are 15-33-6 (.333) in contests decided by two goals or less – 9-15-3 on the road, 6-15-3 at home, and 0-3-0 at neutral sites.

## SERIES NOTES

- ◆ Ferris State and Western Michigan will meet for the 114th and 115th times this weekend in a series which dates back to the 1977-78 season. The Broncos presently have a 64-43-6 lead over the Bulldogs in the all-time series.
- ◆ **OVERTIME** -- Ferris State has compiled a 2-1-5 record in such contests versus Western Michigan.
- ◆ **THE SITE** -- Ferris State is 17-36-3 on the road, 25-24-3 at home, and 1-4-0 at neutral sites against Western Michigan.
- ◆ **BOB DANIELS vs. WESTERN MICHIGAN** -- 25-24-2 overall (10-14-1 on the road, 14-9-1 at home, and 1-1-0 at neutral sites).

**SERIES NOTES** – Ferris State is 21-15-1 (.573) against Western Michigan in the last 37 meetings between the two teams. The Bulldogs are 9-9-0 on the road, 11-5-1 at home, and 1-1-0 at neutral sites versus the Broncos during that period.
