GAMES 25-26 ▲ 2007-08 SEASON

THIS WEEKEND: The Ferris State University men's ice hockey team embarks on a four-game Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) road swing over the next two weeks, beginning this weekend (Feb. 1-2) versus the Lake Superior State University Lakers in Sault Ste. Marie, Mich. The two-game set represents the only regular-season meetings between the two teams for the 2007-08 campaign.

FACEOFF/ARENA: Friday & Saturday – 7:05 p.m. (EST)/Taffy Abel Arena (4,000).

THE BROADCAST: All of Ferris State's 2007-08 CCHA games will be carried live by local radio station **Big Country WWBR-100.9 FM** with **Bill Beckwith** calling the action. The contests can be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at www.ferris.edu/sports. **VIDEO WEBCASTS:** A live video and audio webcast is available for all 2007-08 Ferris State home hockey games through B2Networks for a charge of \$6 per contest. Just click on the B2Networks icon which is located at www.ferris.edu/sports to access.

THE RECORDS: **Ferris State** is currently 10-11-3 overall and 7-9-2 in the CCHA after skating to a 3-3 overtime league tie against Western Michigan last Saturday (Jan. 26) at FSU's Ewigleben Ice Arena in Big Rapids, Mich. The Bulldogs dropped a 4-3 league decision to the Broncos last Friday (Jan. 25) at WMU's Lawson Ice Arena in Kalamazoo, Mich. Ferris State is 5-5-2 in its last 12 encounters to date. FSU is 5-5-0 on the road and 4-6-3 at home this campaign. ➤ Ferris State compiled a 14-22-3 overall record a season ago, which included a ninth-place 10-16-2 CCHA mark.

Lake Superior State improved to 4-16-4 overall and 2-13-3 in CCHA play with a 6-5 overtime league triumph over Ohio State last Saturday (Jan. 26) at LSSU's Taffy Abel Arena in Sault Ste. Marie, Mich. The Lakers gained a split in the two-game CCHA set as Ohio State handed LSSU a 4-3 loss in Friday's (Jan. 25) series opener. The Lakers, who snapped a three-game losing streak with Saturday's victory, are 3-8-0 in home contests this campaign.

➤ A season ago, Lake Superior State posted a 21-19-3 overall mark with an eighth-place 11-14-3 CCHA ledger. LSSU advanced to the semifinals of the 2006-07 CCHA Playoffs as the Lakers made their first semifinal-round appearance since 1996.

THE COACHES: Ferris State – **Bob Daniels**

(Michigan State, 1982), 16th season, 249-297-54 (.460) – (15-24-8 vs. Lake Superior State – 7-12-4 Away, 8-11-4 Home, 0-1-0 Neutral). **Lake Superior State – Jim Roque** (Lake Superior State, 1987), 3rd season, 40-49-14 (.456) – (3-2-4 vs. Ferris State). Roque became the ninth coach in the 41-year history of the Lakers' hockey program in June 2005. He's only the second former Laker player to take the helm of the LSSU program. Roque ranks 19th among LSSU's career scoring leaders and was also a member of the first Laker squad to compete in the 1985 NCAA Division I Tournament.

ABOUT LAKE SUPERIOR STATE: The Lakers have six skaters with double-digit points totals, led by sophomore forward Nathan Perkovich's 16 points (13-3=16). Perkovich is listed 21st among the nation's top statistical leaders in goals per game (0.57 avg.). Senior forward Dan Eves (6-8=14) along with sophomore forward Zac MacVoy (5-9=14) and junior forward Troy Schwab (3-11=14) rank tied for second in team scoring. In goal are freshman Brian Mahoney-Wilson (3-8-2, 3.22 GAA, .893sv%) and sophomore Pat Inglis (1-8-2, 4.48 GAA, .854sv%). LSSU ranks 21st nationally in power-play efficiency (17.3%) and is 59th in penalty-killing (70.9%)

◆ Ferris State is 4-4-3 (.500) in its last 11 outings at Lake Superior State. The Bulldogs are averaging 3.36 goals per game (37 total) during that span while the Lakers have averaged 2.73 goals (30 total).

SERIES NOTES

- ◆ Ferris State and Lake Superior State will meet for the 112th and 113th times this weekend in an all-time series which began in the 1977-78 season. LSSU currently has a 60-39-12 series lead.
- ◆ **OVERTIME** -- Ferris State is 3-2-12 versus LSSU -- 3-1-6 on the road, 0-1-5 at home, and 0-0-1 at neutral sites.
- ◆ **SHUTOUTS** -- Ferris State sports a 3-5-0 mark against Lake Superior State, which includes a 1-5-0 mark in road outings.
- ◆ **THE SITE** -- FSU is 18-31-6 on the road, 20-28-5 at home, and 1-1-1 at neutral sites versus Lake Superior State.
- ◆ **BOB DANIELS vs. Lake Superior State** -- 15-24-8 overall (7-12-4 road, 8-11-4 home, and 0-1-0 neutral).

SERIES NOTES -- Ferris State is 15-10-6 (.581) in its last 31 meetings against Lake Superior State. FSU is averaging 3.13 goals per game (96 total) to LSSU's 2.16 average (67 total) for a +0.93 goals differential during the 31-game stretch.
