SEVEN SCHOOLS REPRESENTED ON CCHA ALL-ACADEMIC TEAM

WESTERN MICHIGAN'S COUSINEAU IS THE LONE RETURNEE

FARMINGTON HILLS, Mich. – For the second time since the award's inception in 1988-89, seven players representing seven different schools have been named to the Central Collegiate Hockey Association all-Academic Team. The award is voted on by the league's faculty representatives. The six players with the most votes are selected. Ties are not broken.

Western Michigan senior David Cousineau is making his second straight appearance on the team while four members - D'Arcy McConvey of Bowling Green, Derrick McIver of Ferris State, David Brisson of Nebraska-Omaha and Scott Titus of Ohio State - received honorable mention in 2001-02.
