### FERRIS HAS EIGHT-GAME WIN STREAK SNAPPED; PLAYS WMU THIS WEEKEND

**THIS WEEK:** The nationally-ranked Ferris State University men's ice hockey team resumes Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) action this weekend (Nov. 15-16) as the Bulldogs face the Western Michigan University Broncos in a home-and-home series. Ferris hosts WMU this Friday (Nov. 15) in Big Rapids, Mich., before venturing to Kalamazoo, Mich., Saturday (Nov. 16) for the series finale.

**FSU TICKET INFORMATION:** Tickets for all 2002-03 FSU home games are available by contacting the Ewigleben Arena Ticket Office at (231) 591-2888. Hours are Monday thru Friday - 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (EST) and Saturday (home games only) - 12 to 5 p.m.

**THE RECORDS:** Ferris State is presently 8-2-0 overall and 6-0-0 in the CCHA following a non-league series split with Wayne State last weekend (Nov. 8-9) at FSU's Ewigleben Ice Arena in Big Rapids, Mich. Ferris skated to a 4-1 victory over the Warriors in last Friday's opening contest before dropping a 5-4 decision in Saturday's series finale. The Bulldogs are ranked 12th for the second consecutive week in the *U.S. College Hockey Online*, *USA Today/American Hockey Magazine* and *Inside College Hockey.com* polls. FSU sports a 4-2-0 home mark and is 4-0-0 in away outings this campaign.

◆ Last season, Ferris State had a 15-20-1 overall record and placed ninth in the CCHA at 12-15-1. FSU was 10-6-0 at home, 5-13-1 on the road, and 0-1-0 at neutral sites.

**Western Michigan** is 3-6-1 overall and 3-5-0 in the CCHA to date following a pair of league losses to Northern Michigan last weekend (Nov. 8-9) at NMU's Berry Events Center in Marquette, Mich. The Broncos suffered a 5-0 setback to the Wildcats last Friday and then lost a 5-2 decision in Saturday's rematch. WMU, which is 1-6-1 in its last eight outings, sports a 1-4-1 road mark and is 2-2-0 at home this season.

◆ Western Michigan finished 19-15-4 overall and 13-12-3 (sixth place) in the CCHA last season.

**BOB DANIELS:** The sixth head coach in the program's history, Daniels became FSU's winningest coach following a 7-0 regular-season finale (3/4/00) win at Western Michigan to surpass the program's inaugural coach Rick Duffett (1975-82; 119-83-7). Daniels ranks first among Ferris' all-time coaches in CCHA wins with a 116-149-29 (.444) league mark.

**Western Michigan - Jim Culhane** (Western Michigan, 1987), 4th season, 57-59-16 (.492 - (7-3-0 vs. Ferris State).

**ABOUT WESTERN MICHIGAN:** The Broncos are led offensively by junior right wing Dana Lattery (6-4-10) and junior center Jeff Campbell (3-7-10). Freshman right wing Brent Walton (4-4-8) and senior defenseman Dave Cousineau (2-6-8) are other top WMU point getters. Sophomore Mike Mantua (1-3-0, 3.93 GAA, .848sv%) and freshman Scott Foster (2-3-1, 4.00 GAA, .848sv%) have split the goaltending duties this season.

**BULLDOG BITES:** Ferris State's 8-2-0 record ties for the best start in program history at the Division I level. In the 1979-80 season, the Bulldogs won their first eight games before losing its next two. That campaign was the Ferris' first as a CCHA member as the team would go on to register a 26-11-1 overall record, including a third-place 11-9-0 league mark . . . The last time FSU won eight games in a row was in the 1990-91 season when the Bulldogs reeled off nine consecutive victories between Nov. 24 and Dec. 30. Ferris went on to post a 23-14-5 overall record and placed third in the CCHA at 15-12-5 under coach Bob Mancini . . . Ferris' 6-0-0 CCHA start is the best in school history. Prior to this campaign, the Bulldogs' best performance after six league outings was 4-2-0 in 1980-81 and again in 1998-99. The 1980-81 squad finished 20-14-2 overall and third in the CCHA at 13-9-0 while the 1998-99 team was 14-16-6

overall, which included a sixth-place 13-12-5 league record . . . Sophomore center **Mike Kinnie's (Shelby)** nine points (5-4-9) in 10 games this campaign equals his offensive output (5-4-9) in 25 outings a season ago . . . Senior left wing **Chris Kunitz (Regina, Sask.)** is two points away from tying Dean Cowling (1985-89) for 19th place on FSU's all-time scoring chart. Kunitz has amassed 118 career points (74-44-118) in 120 contests while Cowling garnered his 120-point career total (51-69-120) in 154 games . . . The Bulldogs have scored 23 of their 49 goals (46.9%) in the third period . . . Ferris is 7-0-0 this year when scoring the game's first goal . . . FSU is averaging 4.9 goals (49 total) in its first 10 outings this campaign while limiting its opponents to 1.7 goals an outing (17) for a +3.2 goal differential. In its initial 10 games a season ago, Ferris averaged 3.3 goals (33) and the opposition scored at a 2.3 goals (23) per game clip for a +1.0 goal margin . . . Freshman defenseman **Jeremy Scherlinck (Grosse Pointe)** has a four-game point string while recording five points (0-5-5) during that streak. His two-point (0-2-2) game last Friday versus Wayne State represented the second multi-point game performance of this season . . . Redshirt frosh right wing **Nick Scheible (Big Rapids)** made his collegiate debut Saturday and was minus one with three shots on goal . . . During its eight-game win streak, Ferris averaged 5.5 goals per game (44 total) and 36.4 shots (291) on net while holding the opposition to 1.2 goals (10) and 31.4 shots on goal . . . FSU is operating at .926 efficiency (25-27) on the penalty kill in its last five contests.

**ALL-AMERICA CANDIDATE:** **Chris Kunitz**, who earned All-CCHA First-Team honors last season as a result of scoring a league-high 25 goals, is a 2002-03 All-America candidate. A season ago, he totaled a career-high 38 points on a career-best 28 goals and 10 assists in 35 games. A two-time CCHA Offensive Player-of-the-Week selection last winter, Kunitz ranked fourth nationally in goals (0.80 gpg) and tied for fourth in game-winning goals (six).
