## TEN PLAYERS ON CCHA ALL-ACADEMIC TEAM FOR FIRST TIME MIAMI'S KOMPON, BGSU'S MCCONVEY & FSU'S MCIVER MAKE RETURN APPEARANCES

**FARMINGTON HILLS, Mich.** – For the first time since the award's inception in 1988-89, 10 players representing eight different schools have been named to the Central Collegiate Hockey Association All-Academic Team. The award is voted on by the league's faculty representatives. The six players with the most votes are selected. Ties are not broken.

Three players return from last year's line-up: Miami's Mike Kompon, Bowling Green's D'Arcy McConvey, and Derrick McIver from Ferris State, while Paul Davies of Western Michigan received Honorable Mention in 2003.
