Lock Haven junior pitcher Kristen Erb, who is trying to lead her team to a second straight NCAA Division II national championship, and Florida Gulf Coast junior third baseman Carmen Paez, who set an Division II home run record during the 2007 season, head up the inaugural Daktronics, Inc./NCAA Division II softball All-America team as the pitcher and player of the year, respectively.

Erb, who has the nation's best earned run average of 0.41 heading into the national championship tournament taking place this weekend in Akron, Ohio, has posted a 36-2 record with 264 strikeouts in 240 2.3 innings of work. Her possible counterpart in the first game of the tournament, Columbus State's Amber Browning, was also a first-team selection after a season in which she went 25-1 with a 0.75 earned run average and nearly 20 strikeouts for every walk.

The third pitcher named to the first team – Florida Southern's Megan Brown – is also pitching in Akron this weekend. Brown posted a 32-8 record with a 0.76 ERA and threw five no-hitters this season.

Paez, who hit 28 home runs to break the Division II record this year, heads up an impressive offensive unit that includes the second-leading hitter in the nation in Kutztown's Steph Denlinger, a .507 hitter with 24 homers and a slugging percentage of 1.111 from her first base position, and outfielder Stacy Haney from Colorado-College Springs, who is the national leader in runs batted in with 93.

The middle infielders selected to the first team were Missouri-Rolla second baseman Kandi Wieberg and Central Missouri shortstop Rachel Adams, both of whom were selected as their conference's "Player of the Year" this spring.

Haney is joined in the outfield by Arkansas-Monticello junior Jenny Dunn and Lincoln Memorial senior Brittany Walker, who earned the South Atlantic Conference "Player of the Year" award after finishing a standout career at her institution.

Angelo State, which had three players named to the overall squad (Macy Baker and Kandace Kubat were third team selections), had a first team choice in designated player Kaycee Taylor. She hit .395 this year and is one of three freshmen to earn All-America honors along with North Carolina Central's Michelle Ishida (second team utility player) and Indianapolis' Megan Russell (third team designated player).

The first team was rounded out by Nova Southeastern's Katie Veltri, who was named as the utility player. Veltri was the Sunshine State Conference's "Player of the Year" after winning the league's triple crown with a .435 average, 12 home runs and 66 runs batted in.
