COLLEGE: 2002: Starting third baseman . . . Has a great arm and one of the best gloves at her position in recent program history . . . Highly accurate on throws . . . Should provide more offense this season . . . Swings the bat with some power and is a solid contact hitter . . . **2001:** Played 37 of 43 contests at the corner . . . Placed fifth among the team's batting average leaders and ranked sixth in total hits . . . Compiled seven multi-hit single-game performances . . . Registered a team-high tying seven-game hitting streak (3/6-10) . . . Belted a solo home run against Findlay (3/9) at the Florida Rebel Spring Tournament . . . Recorded 11 base hits in initial nine outings of the season.

HIGH SCHOOL: A 2000 graduate of Wyoming Rogers High School . . . Two-time all-state and all-region pick . . . Earned all-conference honors three times . . . Help guide the Golden Hawks to a 39-2 record and their four straight conference title as a senior after batting .387 with an on-base percentage of .560 . . . Played an integral role in leading WRHS to the 1999 state championship title and a state runner-up finish in 2000 after recovering from two knee surgeries . . . Hit .451 in junior year as team compiled a 37-2 record . . . Honored as school's 2000 Female Athlete of the Year . . . Three-time captain . . . Served two seasons as captain in volleyball and gained all-league accolades in junior and senior years . . . Member of National Honor Society and S.A.D.D.

Runs well and has quick footwork . . . Brings offensive power to the lineup . . . **2001:** Started in 34 of 36 games played in . . . Led team in batting with a .314 average while finishing fourth on the squad in total base hits and tied for fourth in doubles . . . Tied for 22nd place among GLIAC's overall batting average leaders . . . Notched seven multi-hit single-game efforts, including a four-hit outing vs. Aquinas (3/19) and a three-hit performance against Gannon (4/13) . . . Posted a five-game hit string (4/10-14) with eight total hits . . . Smacked a grand slam home run vs. Concordia (3/10) at Florida Rebel Spring Tourney . . . Notched a team-best .363 on-base percentage . . . **1999-2000:** Played at Grand Rapids CC under coach Paula Maloley . . . All-America Student-Athlete Award winner . . . Two-time all-conference and all-region selection . . . Batted .405 with a team-high 64 hits in 52 games as the Raiders compiled a 22-31 overall mark in 2000 . . . Had 14 doubles, two triples and four homers with 44 RBI in '00.

HIGH SCHOOL: A 1998 graduate of Wayland Union High School . . . Prepped by Cheri Ritz . . . Earned all-state honors during senior season . . .
