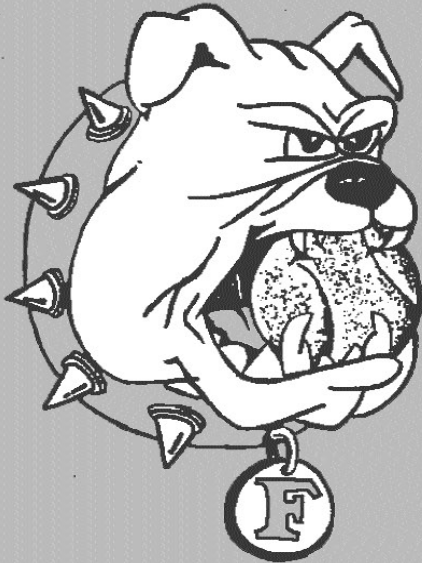

### 2002-03 SEASON NOTES

- ❖ Ferris State has won 175 of its last 178 Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) regular-season matches. The Bulldogs won 162 consecutive league outings from Sept. 4, 1984, to Oct. 12, 2001, when Northwood ended FSU's streak with a 6-3 triumph in Midland, Mich. FSU, which has advanced to the NCAA-II Regional Tournament eight consecutive years (1996-03), has claimed the regional title and earned a bid to the NCAA-II Championships three of the past five seasons to date.
- ❖ Ferris State claimed a share of its 18th league title in the last 19 years at the 2002 GLIAC Tournament with a 5-2 title match win over Northern Michigan (10/26/02) at the Midland Tennis Center in Midland, Mich. The two teams shared the overall championship as NMU won the regular-season crown. FSU finished third overall in 2001 when NMU ended FSU's 17-year GLIAC Championship reign with a 5-4 semifinal victory.
- ❖ **Barbora Jilkova**, who received 2001-02 Intercollegiate Tennis Association Division II Doubles All-America recognition, advanced to the semifinal round in singles play at the 2002 Omni Hotels/Intercollegiate Tennis Association Great Lakes Championships (Oct. 4-6) at the Indianapolis Tennis Center in Indianapolis, Ind. Jilkova and former standout Jennifer Garvey (1998-02) are Ferris' only women's tennis All-America performers. Jilkova and senior **Suzanne Batten** were both named to the first-team 2002 All-GLIAC Team. Freshman **Laura Schaefer** received honorable mention All-GLIAC accolades.
