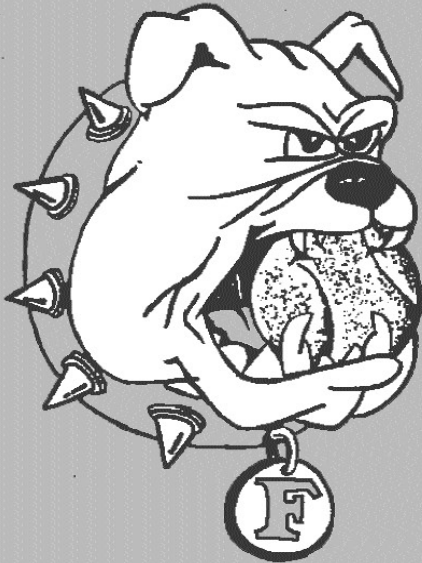

2003-04 SEASON NOTES

- ❖ Ferris State finished second overall at the 2004 GLIAC Tournament as the Bulldogs dropped a 5-1 decision versus Northwood in the title match. The Timberwolves have edged FSU in the final match five consecutive (2000-04) seasons since Ferris claimed the 1999 league title.
- ❖ Junior Jason Cole advanced to the championship match in singles play and earned runner-up honors at the 2003 Omni Hotels/Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) Great Lakes Singles Championship held Sept. 26-28 at the Midland Tennis Center in Midland, Mich. He also teamed up with senior Ian Westermann to finish second in the regional doubles draw.
- ❖ The Bulldogs advanced to the NCAA Division II Regional Tournament for the seventh consecutive year and 10th time overall during the 2003-04 campaign. Ferris claimed a Great Lakes Regional title and earned a bid to the NCAA-II Championships for the fifth consecutive year (2000-04). FSU, which made its eighth appearance in the NCAA-II Sweet Sixteen this campaign, advanced to the national quarterfinals before dropping a 5-0 decision to Rollins (Fla.) in Altamonte Springs, Fla.
- ❖ FSU was ranked 28th in the latest (April 29) Intercollegiate Tennis Association Division II National Poll. The Bulldogs were listed as the Great Lakes Region's second-ranked team.

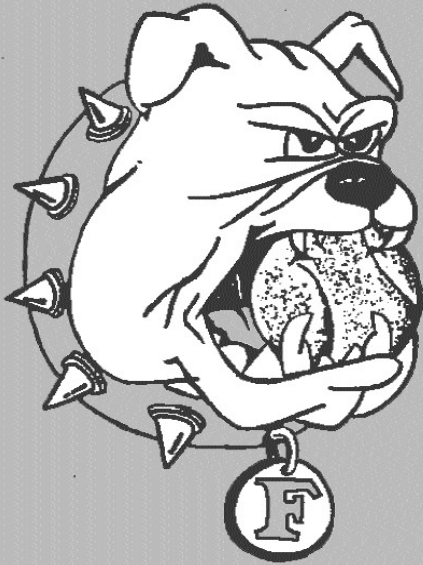
