**Coach Brandel-Wilhelm on Rich:** "Andrea is a quick and agile athlete who has vastly improved her ability to create offense on the court. She's a confident, competitive, and consistent setter."

**College: 2006:** A GLIAC All-Academic Team selection . . . Started 18 of 20 matches played in and participated in 76 games . . . Her 595 assists were second best on the squad . . . Set a career match best with 54 assists at Michigan Tech (9/24) and compiled 53 vs. Augustana (S.D.) at Ferris State Invitational (8/26) . . . Posted 29 service aces to rank sixth among the team's leaders . . . Had career-high five services aces on two occasions – vs. St. Joseph's (Ind.) in season opener (8/24) and vs. Midwestern State (Texas) at Alamo City Classic (9/2) . . . Notched 30 or more assists in eight matches . . . Recorded double figures in digs 13 times, which included a career-high 19 vs. California, Pa. (8/25) along with 17 at Ashland (9/15) . . . **2005:** Saw action in 22 total games . . . Placed third on the team with 92 assists . . . Had 18 assists in the season-opening win over West Virginia State (8/25) . . . Compiled a season-high 23 assists along with nine digs versus Lees-McRae (N.C.) in the Ferris State Holiday Inn Invite (8/26) . . . Totaled 10 assists or more in five different encounters . . . Recorded six digs and six assists against nationally-ranked Central Washington in the Amerihost-Grand Valley State Fall Classic (9/3) . . . **Coach Brandel-Wilhelm on Tye:** "Despite being injured most of the spring, Lindsey grew tremendously in her leadership during the off season. I expect her to be a dynamic force on the court this upcoming season."

**College: 2006:** All-GLIAC Second Team and a GLIAC All-Academic Team member . . . Chosen to Ferris State Invitational and Alamo City Classic All-Tournament Teams . . . Totaled double digits in kills 20 times and had four 20-plus kill matches, including a career-high 35 at Michigan Tech (9/24) . . . Her 35 match kills tied for the second most all-time in the program's annals . . . Placed third on team with 355 kills . . . Led squad in service aces (55) and was second in digs (289) . . . Served a FSU all-time match fifth-place best seven aces vs. Chadron State (Neb.) at the Alamo City Classic (9/1) . . . Finished sixth among league's service ace leaders (0.50 avg.) for all matches . . . Had career-high 27 digs vs. Saginaw Valley State (9/9) and amassed 16 double-figure digs totals in a match . . . **2005:** Started 20 matches and played in 110 games . . . Finished third on squad in kills (283), fourth in digs (211) along with fifth in both total blocks (40) and aces (26) . . . Had more than 10 kills in 13 matches . . .
