College: 2003: Appeared in 18 games . . . Totaled eight kills and seven digs . . . Made her collegiate debut at nationally-ranked North Florida (8/29) . . . Recorded her first career kill against Fairmont State, W.Va. (9/13) . . . Had three kills and two digs at Lake Superior State (11/6) . . . Compiled a .318 attack percentage . . . Added three digs versus Lake Superior State (9/27) . . . Posted a kill apiece versus both Michigan Tech (9/25) and at Saginaw Valley State (10/3).

High School: A 2003 graduate of Lakewood High School . . . Attained all-region, all-county and All-Capital Circuit League kudos three times (2001-03) . . . Guided Lakewood to a regional tournament berth in 2002-03 . . . Led LHS to a 64-6-2 overall record and a state semifinal berth in 2001-02 . . . Compiled 592 kills as a junior . . . Totaled four varsity letters under head coach Kelly Rowland . . . Twice (2001-02) garnered Big Red Invitational All-Tournament Team accolades . . . Led the Vikings to the state quarterfinals two seasons (2000-01) as LHS registered a 121-14-3 mark during that span . . . Set a school record for service points . . . Also participated in softball, tennis and basketball . . . Listed among *Detroit Free Press'* Top 50 Softball Players To Watch in 2003 . . . **Club Team:** Played for the Team Angle Volleyball squad, which was coached by Trent Smillie.

Coach Brandel-Wilhelm on Miller: "Sarah's a powerful blocker who's capable of making the big defensive play. She's worked hard to become a complete volleyball player and has the ability to play both the outside and right-side positions."

College: 2003: Played in 26 matches . . . Netted 35 kills and 25 total blocks . . . Tallied six kills versus West Virginia Wesleyan (9/12) . . . Totaled five digs and four blocks against North Alabama (9/5) . . . Added four kills apiece at Saginaw Valley State (10/3) and Northwood (10/4) . . . Compiled four blocks in the season-opening match at North Florida (8/29) . . . Recorded three kills versus Saginaw Valley State (10/31) . . . **2002:** Saw action in 11 matches . . . Notched 17 kills, seven digs and four block assists in 18 games . . . Totaled a season-high four kills versus Saginaw Valley State (9/28) . . . Posted three kills and two block assists against Lake Superior State (10/26) . . . Had three digs and two block assists in a win over Ashland (10/4) . . . Recorded first career kill in her debut versus Bellarmine (8/31) . . . Garnered the squad's second-best season attack percentage (.295) . . . **2001:** Redshirted.

High School: A 2001 graduate of John Glenn High School . . . Two-time member of the *Bay City Times* "Dream Team" . . . Was a two-time first-team all-region selection . . . Tallied 138 kills, 78 service aces and 73 solo blocks for the Bobcats as a junior . . . Served as the Bobcats' team captain . . . Named to the All-Northeast Michigan Conference Team three times . . .
