HANS BAJARIA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION & SELECTION CRITERIA 2013 / 2014 ACADEMIC YEAR

I. Application Criteria

- A. The student shall be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours (or equivalent) of undergraduate study in the Manufacturing Engineering and Welding Technology program or the BSQET program. Preference will be given to any applicant enrolled in the BSQET program.
- B. The student shall have had a minimum grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) in high school or in the last year of collegiate studies completed.

II. Selection Criteria

- A. Relevance of field of study with higher preference given with increased exposure and importance of the Quality Sciences within that curriculum. Preference will be given to those students enrolled in the BSQET program.
- B. Content of written goal statement, including evidence of clear direction, commitment and relevance of quality methods and tools.
- C. Academic performance, as measured by GPA.
- D. Financial need: financial info not required with application, but any discernable indication of need will be considered.
- E. Commitment, as inferred and evidenced by factors such as written goal statement, course load, consistency in course of study, membership and involvement in professional societies or their student chapters, etc.
- F. Quality and structure of written goal statement, including grammar, spelling, coherence of argument, and general writing proficiency.
- G. Organizational activities, as evidenced by membership and involvement in professional societies or their student chapters. Other types of organizational activities may also be considered.
