FIRST Robotics Scholarship

In partnership with *FIRST*, Ferris State University has established a merit-based scholarship to recognize the achievements of the *FIRST* Robotics Competition and *FIRST* Tech Challenge participants. This scholarship will provide one \$2,000 scholarship that can be utilized in **any** program of study.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the *FIRST* scholarship:

- Applicant must have participated in the *FIRST* Robotics Competition or *FIRST* Tech Challenge.
- Student must provide documentation confirming participation in the *FIRST* Robotics Competition or the *FIRST* Tech Challenge.
- Applicant shall be an incoming freshman enrolled full-time in any major.

Scholarship Application Package Contents

To apply for the *FIRST* scholarship, complete the application package including:

- A completed Ferris State University *FIRST* Robotics Scholarship application
- A letter of recommendation from an adult mentor or coach on your *FIRST* team
