General Education requirements for a B.S., BA, BAS, BIS, BSW Degree

Communication Competence: 12 credit hours

- English composition requirement – 6 credit hours; Choose ENGL 150; and ENGL 250 OR 211
- Speech communication requirement – 3 credit hours; Choose one of the following: COMM 105, 121, 221 or 251
- Advanced English/Speech requirement – at least 3 credit hours; Choose one of the three options:
 1. ENGL 311, 321, 323, or 325
 2. Two "Writing Intensive (WIC) courses plus one additional COMM course (200 level or higher)
 3. Three WIC Courses

Quantitative Skills: See Options on Right

Scientific Understanding: 7 credit hours

- Choose two Scientific Understanding courses, one of which must have a lab

Cultural Enrichment: 9 credit hours

- Choose three cultural enrichment courses
- At least ONE course at the 200-level or higher
- No more than 5 credit hours in cultural enrichment activities courses may apply to this requirement

Social Awareness: 9 credit hours

- Choose three Social Awareness courses, in at least two different subject areas
- One of the Social Awareness courses must be a Foundations course
- One of the Social Awareness courses must be at the 200-level or higher

Race-Ethnicity-Gender: one course

- Please note that many R/E/G courses also meet Social Awareness or Cultural Enrichment requirements.

Global Consciousness: one course

- Please note that many Global courses also meet Social Awareness or Cultural Enrichment requirements.

Quantitative Skills Requirement

Complete one of the following options:

1. Pass MATH 115 or higher
2. Pass a course proficiency exam for MATH 115 or higher
3. Submit an ACT math subtest score of 24 or higher, plus 1 year of high school algebra with a grade of C- or better
4. Submit a Compass Algebra score of 61 or higher, plus 1 year of high school algebra with a grade of C- or better
5. Submit a SAT math score of 560 or higher, plus 1 year of high school algebra with a grade of C- or better
