The SLA section had a 53% pass rate which was 39% lower than the control section and 27% lower than the non-SLA sections. The SLA section had 7% withdrawals and 15% failures while the control group had 8% withdrawals and 3% failures. The non-SLA sections had 10% withdrawals and 7% failures. The SLA sections had a pass rate of 84% in spring 09 and the pass rate for the control group and non-SLA sections were 75% and 85%.

Note: The instructor of the SLA section reported that 10 students missed class regularly or stopped coming after the first two weeks and did not withdraw.

The SLA section had 3% withdrawals while the non-SLA sections had 7% withdrawals and 4% failures. The pass rate for the SLA section in Spring 09 was 15% higher than in Spring 10.

Note that the SLA sections had lower HSGPA's and ACT scores.

The pass rate for SLA was 75% which was 15% higher than the non-SLA sections. SLA continues to be very effective in helping students pass Math 110. Course withdrawal rates were about the same, but SLA sections reported an 8% failure rate compared to a 31% failure rate in the non-SLA sections. The SLA pass rate was slightly higher in Spring 09(80%) and the non-SLA pass rate was 15% (45%) lower in Spring 09.

Note: Statistics were hand calculated in the non-SLA sections due to the fact that a Math 110 professor did not have grades in on time. Due to this technicality IRT was unable to calculate the grades in the non-SLA sections and student grades had to be looked up individually and recalculated.
