



## Final Report, Spring 2011

The following report includes a summary of SLA activities from the spring 2011 semester.

### Program Statistics

- SLA was offered with 39 sections of 17 courses.
- SLA workshops were attached to more sections in Spring 11, but more courses were offered in Spring 10.
- SLA served 905 students in Spring 11 which was 64 more than students served in spring 10.

### New Courses and Initiatives

- There were no new courses offered with SLA this semester.
- There were two new faculty members participating in SLA for Spring 2011 and two new facilitators.
- BIOL 108 with Professor Ryan will have SLA attached again in the fall 2011 due to the high success rate in the past.
- PHAR 311 will be a new addition to SLA in fall 11. The pharmacy professors are hoping that SLA will prevent students from having to remediate in the summer.

### Outcomes for Spring 11

- CHEM 114 continues to be very successful with SLA. There was an 81% pass rate of a C- or better with the SLA sections and a 62% pass rate with the control group. The professor had an A- on tests as the threshold for students to attend the SLA.
