Ferris State University Tuition and Student Fees Committee

The Tuition and Student Fees Committee is a campus wide committee charged by the President to review and make advisory recommendations to the President regarding tuition rates, tuition structures, tuition policy, and all changes in student fees.

The Committee is comprised of members representing the following campus units:

- · Budget Office, Director chairs the Committee
- Faculty (2 members appointed to serve staggered two-year terms, appointments made by the Academic Senate)
- Students (2 members appointed by The Student Government)
 Representatives from the following campus offices:
- · Academic Affairs
- Auxiliary Enterprises
- Enrollment Services
- Financial Aid Office
- · Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University
- Student Affairs
- Student Financial Services
- · University Advancement and Marketing

The Committee typically meets from January to early April to complete its work, with their advisory recommendations submitted to the President by mid-April.
