COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course will prepare specialty nurses in scholarly critique of current evidence to identify the foundational steps of evidenced-based practice (EBP). The focus will be on the translation of EBP from research literature to implementation in professional practice.

3 credits (3+0) 3 lecture hours / week = 45 hours / semester Pre-requisite: N U R S 5 0 1

COURSE OUTCOMES:

- 1. Examine levels of evidence and their relevancy to various Health Care settings and nursing practice (Theoretical Basis for Practice).
- 2. Make recommendations for practice change in one's specialty area that are supported by current evidence (Collaborative Leadership) (Specialty Leadership Role in Practice) (Scholarship for Practice).
- 3. Evaluate clinical problems in the healthcare environment by critiquing current evidence from nursing and other disciplines(Health Care Environment) (Professionalism)
