MARCH

FIRST STEPS

- Meet with your high school counselor and/or principal to discuss the dual enrollment program
- Review the information about fall registration on www.ferris.edu/dualenrollment
- Complete the online FerrisNow application available at bit.ly/FerrisNowApplication

- If possible, attend the dual enrollment information meeting at Ferris on March 5

APRIL-AUGUST

REGISTRATION, ACCEPTANCE LETTERS, ORIENTATION

- Registration for Ferris dual enrollment students will open on April 4 (you will be registered by the FerrisNow program staff)
- Students who are accepted will receive an acceptance letter from Ferris State University in mail (the letter will include your student ID number and information about accessing MyFSU)
