Additional academic challenge beyond the high school level

Develop your college readiness skills in a real college classroom

You may be eligible for a \$1,000 FerrisNext Scholarship if you earn at least three college credits with a "C" or higher through Ferris while you were in high school, and choose to attend Ferris as a college freshman
