Eligibility

To be eligible you must:

- Have graduated from high school
- Be accepted to a degree-granting program at Ferris State University
- Enroll full-time at a Ferris State University site within one year of graduation (with the exception of Kendall College of Art and Design)
- Have successfully earned a "C" or better in at least three credits through a Ferris collaborative high school agreement
