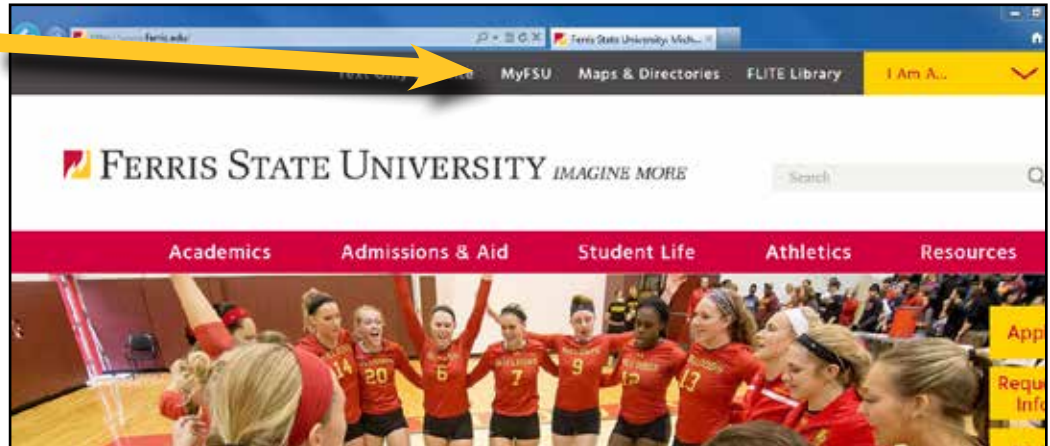
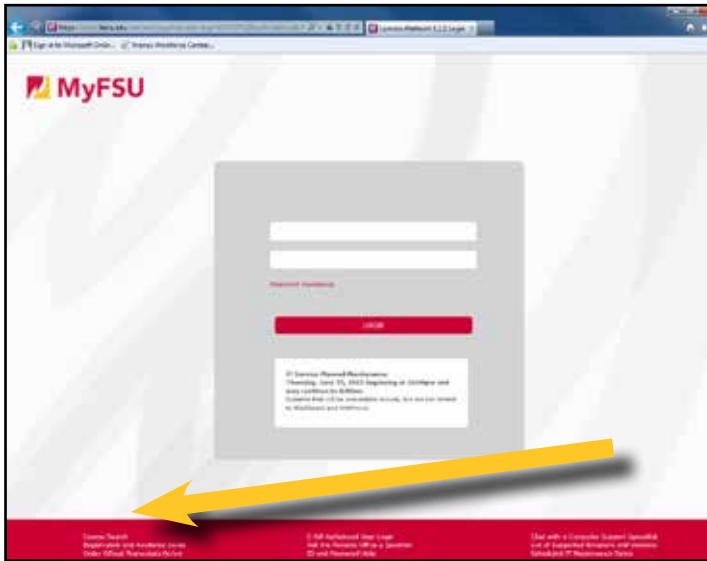


1. Go to the Ferris State University Homepage (www.ferris.edu).

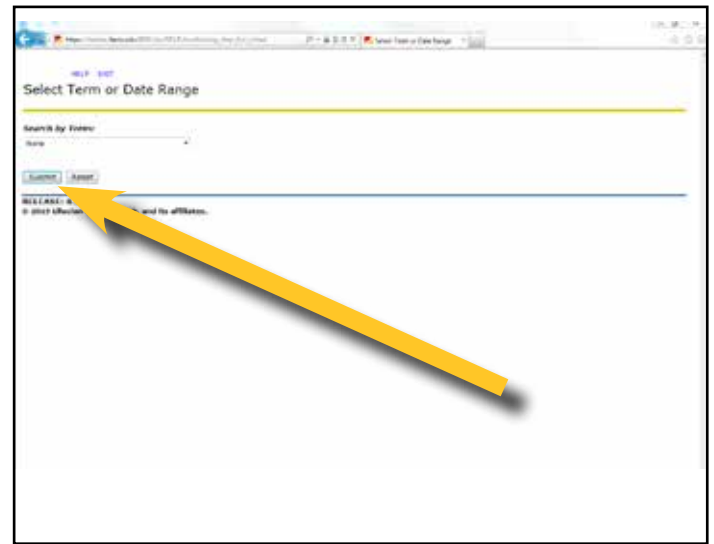
- Click on MyFSU located at the top of the page.
- This will take you to the MyFSU login page.



2. Click on the “Course Search” link on the MyFSU login page.



3. Select the term from the drop down menu that you are searching for classes. Click submit.



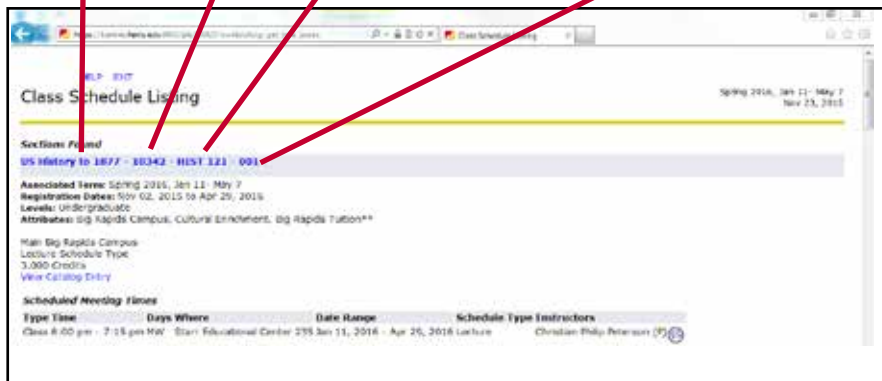
4. Enter your search criteria for classes.



- There are instructions provided at the top of the “Class Schedule Search” page.
- To narrow down the options, you can select the subject, enter the course number, and choose specific times and days.
- You can also leave the time and days blank to see all the courses that are available for a specific subject and course number.
- **Your campus selection must be “Main Big Rapids.”**
- After you have made your selections, click “Class Search” at the bottom of the page.

5. Select your classes from the search results.

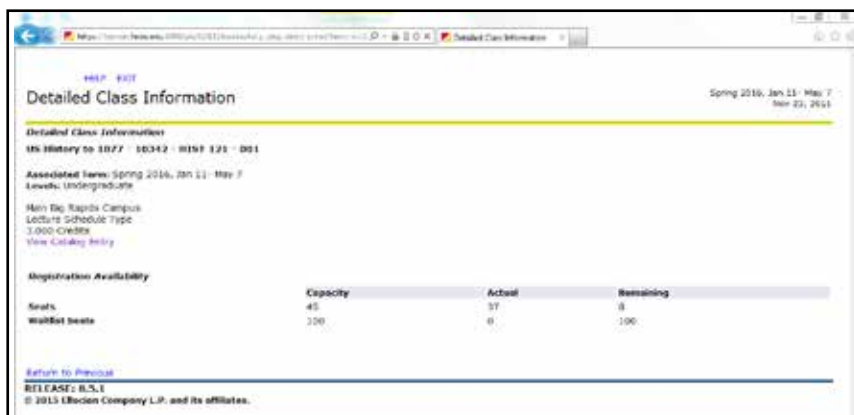
Course Title CRN Course Prefix & Number Section Number



- Courses that meet the criteria you selected will appear.
- Write down the **Course Reference Number (CRN)**, **Course Prefix and Number**, **Section Number**, and **Course Title** of the classes you are interested in, as you will need to include this information on the Course Permission and Payment Authorization Form.
- Click on the Course Title of the section you are interested in to view the detailed class information.

Class days abbreviations are:
 M=Monday
 T=Tuesday
 W=Wednesday
 R=Thursday
 F=Friday

6. View the detailed class information.



- View the detailed class information to see the registration availability for an individual course.
- “Capacity” represents the maximum seats available in that section.
- “Actual” shows how many students have registered at the time of your search.
- “Remaining” shows how many seats are available at the time of your search.
