General Conditions & Requirements:

1. Student must apply for Articulated Credit at Ferris State within two years of high school graduation.
2. Student must complete the Articulated Credit Application/Verification form, obtain appropriate signatures, and send the form to Ferris State University's Transfer Services Center.
3. Student must complete course competencies with a "B" or better final grade.





