

# Articulation Agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transition of students from high school occupational and/or Career and Technical Education (CTE) program to Ferris State University. Program is offered at all State-Approved Career and Technical Programs in Michigan.

**General Conditions & Requirements:**

1. Student must apply for Articulated Credit at Ferris State within two years of high school graduation.
2. Student must complete the Articulated Credit Application/Verification form, obtain appropriate signatures, and send the form to Ferris State University's Office of Transfer and Secondary School Partnerships.
3. Student must complete course competencies with a "B" or better final grade.
4. To receive credit for TDMP 136, the student needs to submit a Demo Reel (portfolio) for TDMP faculty review.
5. To receive credit for TDMP 243, the student needs to submit a Demo Reel (portfolio) for TDMP faculty review.


