- How/when to get tested
 - ✓ Symptomatic/Exposure—Birkam or Spectrum
 - ✓ Asymptomatic—Campus testing periodically
- Understanding Isolation vs. Quarantine
 - ✓ Isolation—Tested positive or experiencing symptoms (~10 days)
 - ✓ Quarantine—Have had exposure to a positive case but are not experiencing symptoms (~14 days)
