

Vehicle Registration & Parking

Did you know?

- *Did you know* that anyone parking on University property **must** display a valid parking permit? That includes all guests of the University, except those who pay to park at a meter!
- *Did you know* when you come into our office for any type of permit you **must** bring in your current vehicle registration and driver's license?
- *Did you know* that the Campus Police is open 24 hours per day/7 days per week? A temporary and/or guest permit can be obtained 24 hours per day. Students will be issued a temporary permit valid until noon the next business day.
- *Did you know* that you can order your parking permit online through your MyFSU portal? They will be ready to be picked up by the next business day.
- *Did you know* your guests can order their own guest permit online and print it off instead of coming to our office?
- *Did you know* if you park at a meter you **must** pay the meter fee? After 5:00 P.M. meters are free, except at the Rock where they are enforced until 8:00 P.M. Parking at meters is prohibited from 2:00 A.M.-6:00 A.M.
- *Did you know* you cannot park at a commuter or faculty/staff lot overnight?
- *Did you know* parking decals must be **fully affixed with their own adhesive** to the passenger side, lower front corner of the windshield?
- *Did you know* all motorcycles or mopeds must be registered to park on campus? Motorcycles or mopeds may not be parked at a bicycle rack.
- *Did you know* if you have a residence hall or apartment parking permit you may only park in your assigned lot on campus during the day Monday through Friday or pay to park at a meter? After 5:00 P.M., you may park in a commuter or faculty/staff lot until 2:00 A.M and then you **must** return to your assigned lot.
- *Did you know* if your permit is damaged in any way, you **must** exchange it for a new permit? A ticket will be issued for unlawful display if not replaced.
- *Did you know* that you can exchange your permit for \$1.00, if you bring a different vehicle to campus or get your windshield replaced, by returning your old permit for exchange? **If you do not return your old permit it, is \$130 to get a new permit.**
- *Did you know* you cannot leave a disabled vehicle on campus?
- *Did you know* there are is drop box to pay your ticket? It is located in the main lobby of the Campus Police Office. You can also pay online at ferris.edu/parking or through your MyFSU portal.
- *Did you know* when your tickets are transferred to your student account they are still considered "unpaid" until the amount has been paid in full either on your student account or in our office?
- *Did you know* you have a 5 day grace period to pay/appeal your ticket before it is assessed a \$5.00 late fee?
- *Did you know* when you appeal a parking ticket you must post a bond in the amount of the ticket and fill out an appeal form in the office?
- *Did you know* that the Appeals Committee are FSU students, who do not work for Campus Police?
- *Did you know* altering a parking permit is a civil infraction? A ticket will be issued with a court appearance and parking privileges may be suspended or revoked.
- *Did you know* on FSU campus all legal parking spaces are marked with yellow lines, even along curbs where parking is allowed? **No yellow lines, you are in violation!**
- *Did you know* you cannot park a trailer on campus?
- **Did you know you are responsible for knowing the Parking Rules and Regulations?** All Parking Rules & Regulations can be found on the back of the campus map or on our web site. If you have questions as to where you need to park or where your overflow lot is, call 231-591-5000.
