LEARNING OUTCOMES

In this advising session, advisors will learn how transfer credits from other colleges are evaluated, understand what the various designations attached to courses mean when courses don't transfer as direct equivalents, learn to spot errors in evaluations, and be introduced to both the old and new MACRAO policies with an explanation as to whom they apply to and how they differ.

As a result of participation in this hands-on session, you will be able to:

- Access student transcript evaluations via Self Serve Banner (SSB) and interpret those documents.
- Determine how transfer credits will be used in students' programs including transcripts with both the old and new MACRAO policies.
- Find direct equivalents for Ferris courses at other colleges.
- Learn how to work with General Education courses that do not directly equate to Ferris courses
