## 1. Minutes

## 2. Policies and Procedures

Draft Recertification Forms: Application and Evaluation

The forms for recertification were approved by a vote of 4 to 2. The two votes against approving the forms objected to the label "United States Diversity" on the form for DIVU. This will be changed once the name change of the category is in effect.

During the discussion, the following questions and comments were raised and deserve further consideration:

- 1. What is the process for courses that are not put forward for certification?
- 2. What is the process for courses that are not recertified?
- 3. We should have a central depository such as a share drive to maintain the evidence that is required for the recertification application.

## 3. Proposals

Self and Society: READ 176
