- 5. Discussion with Guest Deedee Stakley: Credit for Military Veterans

Deedee Stakley described a "Credit for Credentials" process – credit for military deployment fits into this framework. Other examples include HVAC certification for apprenticeships, Criminal Justice credit for credits from Police Academy.

Two forms of deployment: outside of US and within US.

Streamlines process, and agreements once approved are put into banner as equivalencies.

Goal: deployed outside of US – 6 credits of CULT (including DIV, US and Global) and 3 for SSOC. Stationed within US – 3 credits of CULT (including US DIV) and 3 SSOC.

Students would provide DD214, which would be verified before added to transcript.

Other experiences (COMM, MATH for example) would still go through APL.

- Could include minimum time frame for deployment. Maybe 3 months minimum. (or 9 months minimum?)
- Credit for credentials not currently on website working on developing it. Larger context would help identity what this is.
- Can we compare to other universities across the state and identify best practices?
- How is learning documented, in terms of outcomes? This type of agreement is similar to Michigan Transfer Agreement. APL does include this kind of documentation; Credit for Credential is based on the credentials. No real way to know what kind of training student has experienced, such as how learned and applied theories and methods.
- Concerns about Race, Ethnicity, and Gender military has documented issues with racism and sexism. Would like more information regarding US Diversity.
- DD214 usually doesn't cover much. Perhaps we could ask for more documentation beyond the DD214. For example: student could provide a document outlining how met the requirements or the outcomes in their experience or training. Could provide students with a form with outcomes for each competency, an example for how they might be met, and a box to enter text stating an example of how they met and used the outcome.
