^{*} Assessment has been expected by our accreditor since about 1985. TracDat was implemented in 2008. By Spring 2014, we expect that results for all outcomes at the program level have been entered. Because use of TracDat for course assessment reporting was launched later, by the end of academic year 2013-14 we expect that most course-level outcomes have results reported and that beginning with 2014-15, reporting will be conducted annually for one-third of program and course-level outcomes so that in every three-year period results are reported for all outcomes.
