The spring testing window will close at the end of the day on Friday, June 8. No extensions will be given. Please make sure that you have closed your testing window and marked your testing window complete before you leave for the day on June 8th. I hope to be able to run reports and give you preliminary summary information within the next week.

School leaders should have received a form to fill out to estimate usage for the 2018-2019 school year. If you haven't filled out that form yet, please do so ASAP. NWEA MAPgrowth for Reading and

Math will still continue to be free of charge for you in grades K-10; however, this cost will now be split between our office and the Michigan Department of Education. Note: THIS IS NOT A **REPLACEMENT FOR MSTEP.** Schools will still have to administer the MSTEP just like this year. This new feature is just providing an additional benchmark assessment for schools for grades 3-8.

Professional Development

Our partnership with the Grand Valley State University Charter Schools Office will continue for next year, and it's better than ever! Now any teacher can attend any of their professional development offerings free of charge. We will continue to offer to pay for any session to be held at your school; however, this must be preapproved.
