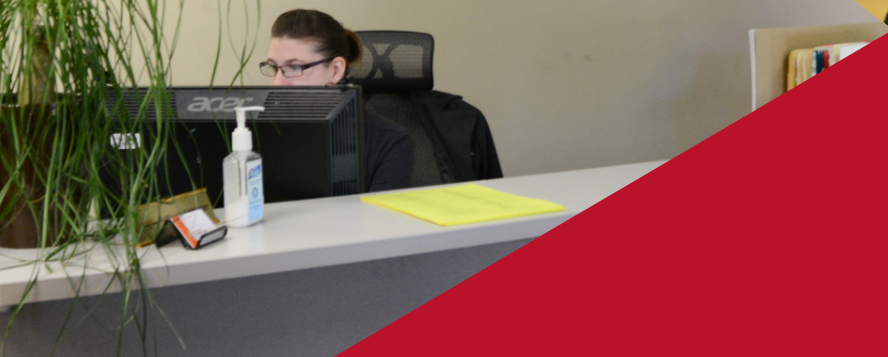

Excellence

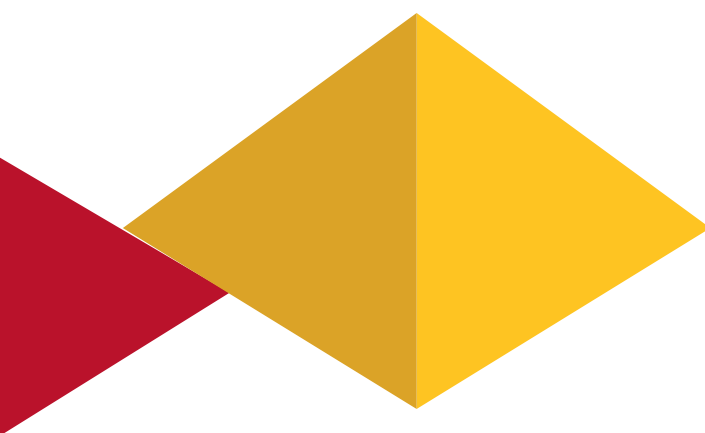

Welcome to the 2022 edition of the Ferris State University Charter Schools Office Annual Report! Thank you for taking the time to learn more about Ferris State's Michigan public school academies and our work as a Michigan PSA Authorizer.

From our humble beginnings in 1997 with the authorization of Northridge Academy as our first PSA, the Ferris portfolio now includes 19 academies with an enrollment of just under 10,000 students. During the ensuing years we have learned a great deal about authorizing, the role of public-school academies in the Michigan educational landscape, and the difference these schools can make in student's lives. Yet we realize that despite our 24 years of experience and all we have learned, there is still a great deal of work to do; such is the nature of the rapidly changing field of education and PSA authorizing.

Due to its very nature, this Annual Report looks backward to the performance of our academies from the past academic year. More comprehensive information relative to student academic achievement and growth from tests such as the NWEA and M-Step are published in each school's Contract Performance Report (CPR) which were released to academies early this fall.

Our Charter Schools Mission states: "We will endeavor and expect that we will authorize public school academies that promise to "transform the lives of students by demonstrating high-quality performance." This is our one "non-negotiable" and our pledge that no matter how long we authorize PSAs, we will not waiver from this, our foundational core.

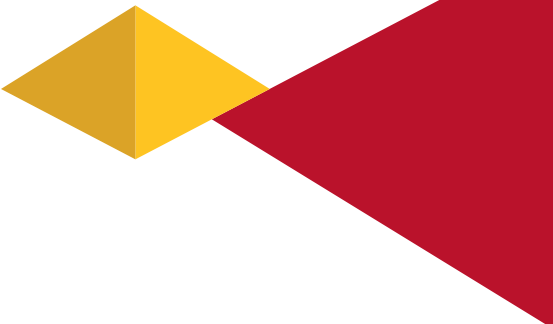

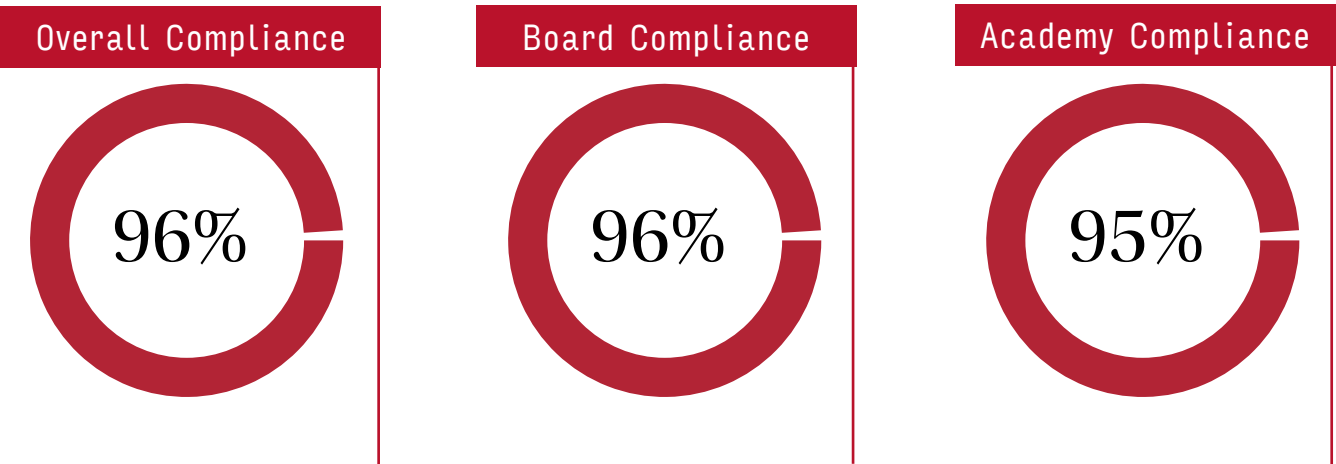

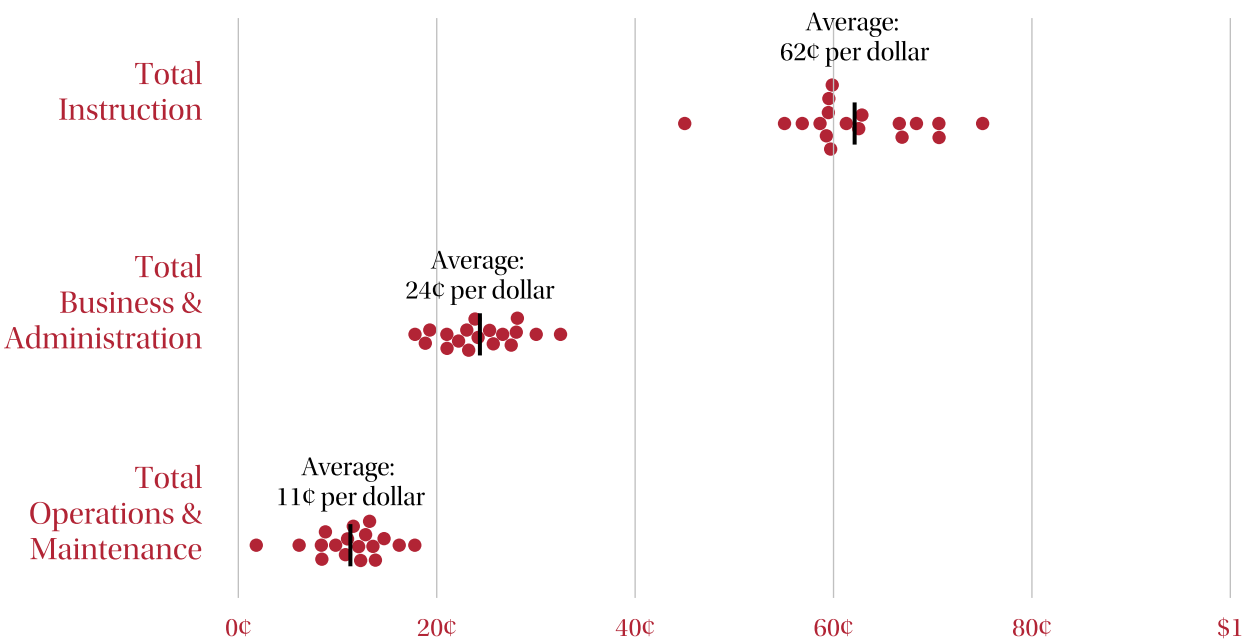

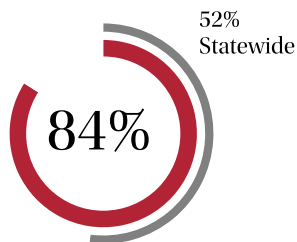
Student Enrollment Over Time



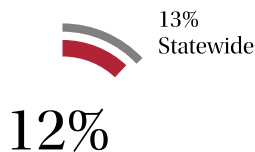
Breakdown of Student Ethnicity



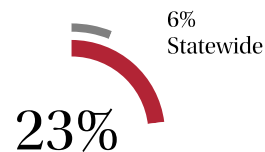
Students who Qualify for Free & Reduced Price Lunch

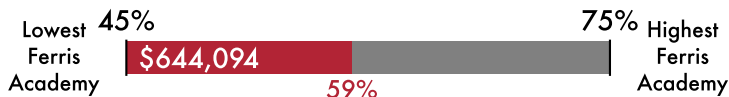

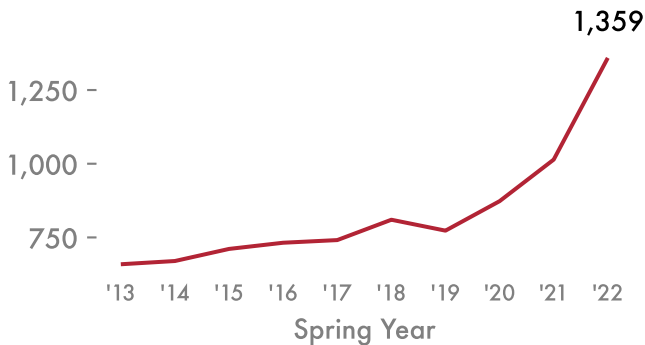

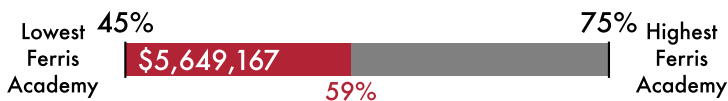
ENROLLMENT BY YEAR

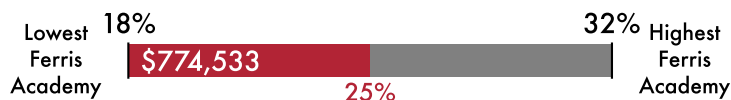
