New Hope Public School Academy. New Hope was authorized by the Ferris State University Board of Trustees at their October meeting for a period of five years. Located in Saginaw, the Academy is an outgrowth of the Samaritas Community Center which has served their Saginaw neighborhood for over 70 years. The Academy is slated to open in the Fall 2019 and will be managed by Choice Schools Associates.

Congratulations to **New Bedford Academy** on being Reauthorized for a period of five years by the FSU Board of Trustees. New Bedford Academy, located in Lambertville, was one of the schools in FSU's inaugural class of public school academies, and also recently celebrated their 20th year of operation. New Bedford is managed by Educational Partnerships, Inc.



Lighthouse Academy, with its main campus located in Grand Rapids, was granted authority to open their seventh campus under their FSU Charter, this campus is located in Charlevoix. The Academy, designated as a Strict Discipline Academy, will be serving adjudicated, probationary and incarcerated youths in the Charlevoix and East Jordan community. Lighthouse is managed by Integrity Educational Services in Grand Rapids.
