

Articulation Agreement

Ferris State University
AND

All State-Approved Career and Technical Education Programs in Michigan

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transition of students from high school and/or Career and Technical Education (CTE) program to Ferris State University. Program is offered at all State-Approved Career and Technical Education Programs in Michigan.

General Conditions & Requirements

1. Application for Articulated Credit must be received within two years of the student's high school graduation. Exceptions to this condition must be approved by the Office of Transfer and Secondary School Partnership.
2. The [FerrisNow Secondary Articulated Credit Application](#) will be completed and submitted by the high school/tech center representative. All supporting documentation will be submitted to FerrisNow@ferris.edu.
3. Student must earn a "B" or higher in the applicable CTE program to be eligible for articulated credit.
4. To earn credit for HEQT 101, student must pass the FSU articulation assessment with a score of 80% or higher.
5. To earn credit for HEQT 120, student must present ASE Exam T2 Diesel Engines credentials
6. To earn credit for HEQT 210, student must present ASE Exam T6 Electrical Systems credentials.
7. To earn credit for HEQT 240, student must present ASE Exam T4 Brakes and ASC Exam T6 Suspension and Steering credentials.
