2. UCC Statement of Purpose:

The University Curriculum Committee screens proposals for curriculum additions and revisions to ensure that they are consistent with the best interests of the University and meet the rapidly changing needs of the workforce. It is the intent of the Committee to conduct the reviews as expeditiously as possible in a manner that facilitates development of new proposals and updates existing programs.

3. The UCC received 113 proposals, 76 proposals were approved, 2 were withdrawn, 18 were experimental courses or course cap changes that did not require UCC action and 17 will carry-over to the 2018-2019 UCC agenda.
4. For next year, the manual will be rewritten, the UCC forms updated and the process streamlined to involve the proposer early in the process to minimize errors. The committee will continue to monitor and adjust the process as needed to best serve the University.
