18-083	Course Modification: MGMT 370	<p>Emily moved to approve, Sue seconded. The outcomes state “understand,” which is not detailed enough. Assessment is also not detailed enough either.</p> <p>Proposal will be held, to improve outcomes and assessment. 8-0</p>
18-098	MIMG Curriculum Redirection	<p>Proposal has not gone for second review at RAM.</p> <p>Dave moved to approve, Sue seconded.</p> <p>E/F’s for MIMG 192 and 292 list the exact same outcome, and only lists one outcome. The committee expects that a 200 level course would have different, more advanced outcomes than a 100 level course.</p> <p>There is no Form C.</p> <p>MIMG 101 has an outcome which uses the word “understand.” This is too vague.</p> <p>Proposal will be held for these changes. 8-0</p>
