Proposal Number	Title	Action/Votes	Senate Action / Concerns/Reasons/Updates
18-001	New Degree - Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene	No Action	This proposal is currently waiting to be approved by RUM (previously the pre-UCC). 18-001 will be the top priority of the Tuesday meeting of RUM, and should be ready for UCC discussion next meeting.
18-003	Honors Program - Bachelor's Certificate	No Action	Has a typo on second page. Currently waiting on paperwork from Honors Program.
18-004	Honors Program - Associate's Certificate	No Action	Has a typo on second page. Currently waiting on paperwork
18-007	New Certificate - Computerized Business Applications	Approved – 7 Votes	A question came up regarding the outcomes for the certificate. The outcome listed seemed weak. However, details for outcomes might also be included within the courses, as opposed to the overall outcome for the certificate. No other issues were found with this proposal.

18-009	BSN Pre-Licensure Elective Clinical Course	Approved – 7 Votes	<p>There is a blank Form B included in this proposal. This is thought to signify that there are no other departments that will be impacted by this proposal, and therefore, no need for a Form B.</p> <p>This proposal was also missing the first page of EF, which was discovered to have been stuck to another piece of paper and not included in the original scan.</p>
18-011	BS in Biology, Concentration in Pre-Physician Assistant Studies (BIPA)	Hold	<p>There is a form EF with this proposal with no changes, as well as only two form B's when there were three form B's noted in the proposal. If a Form B was not returned from Social Science, a note must be included from the proposer. Katherine will follow up on this note.</p> <p>This proposal will go through as a concentration, not a major, as per Elise.</p>
18-012	NC - Spanish for Heritage Speakers	Hold	<p>Background: This course is for Spanish oral speakers who are too strong orally for the standard intro class, but too weak in written Spanish to do well in the more advanced Spanish courses.</p> <p>There are no checksheets included in this proposal. When dealing with equivalencies, and for accountability, checksheets should be included.</p>
